Mercer Vicinage to Host Seminar on Will Planning and Power of Attorney

The Mercer Vicinage, in partnership with Central Jersey Legal Services, Inc., will hold a free seminar on will planning and power of attorney on Tuesday, April 9 from 10:30 a.m. to noon at the Ewing Branch Library, 61 Scotch Road, Ewing.

The seminar, Planning for the Unexpected: Last Will and Testament and Power of Attorney, will address issues such as what happens to assets after death and how to implement a plan that directs how and to whom the assets will be distributed.

Central Jersey Legal Services attorney Kalea Edmundo also will discuss how to direct others to make medical and financial decisions on one's behalf in the event of incapacitation.
