Judges to Conduct Election Day Hearings in Atlantic and Cape May Counties

Superior Court judges will be available in Atlantic and Cape May counties to conduct hearings for election challenges or issues on Tuesday, July 7.

Anyone seeking to petition the court on a voting or election issue on the date of the election can contact the Superior Court in Atlantic County at 609-402-0100, ext. 47594 or at ATLCIVILADMIN.Mailbox@njcourts.gov and the Superior Court in Cape May County at 609-402-0100, ext. 47910 or at CPMLawDiv.mailbox@njcourts.gov.

Those who are unable to access the courts by phone or email can appear in person at the Atlantic County Civil Courthouse in Atlantic City, the Atlantic County Criminal Complex in Mays Landing, or the Cape May County Superior Court in Cape May Courthouse. If appropriate, the matter will be heard promptly by the designated judge with notice to election officials. Election officials, petitioners, and attorneys will be able to appear before the designated judge by video or telephone.
