Superior Court Judges Available to Conduct Election Day Hearings

Superior Court judges will be available across the state to conduct hearings for election challenges or issues on Tuesday, Nov. 3.

If appropriate, the election matter will be heard by a designated judge and notice will be provided to election officials. Voters with election challenges or issues who are unable to access the courts by phone or email can appear in-person at a courthouse. When possible, hearings will be held at non-court locations, such as the county board of elections or another county facility.

Election officials, voters and attorneys can appear before the judge by video or telephone. All COVID-19 health protocols will be followed, including health screening, face mask and social distancing requirements, and the use of Plexiglas or other barriers.

Voters seeking to petition the court on a voting or election issue on Tuesday can contact their county courthouse. Those who have questions about the election or who are seeking assistance casting their vote can contact their respective county clerk's office and/or board of elections.
