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Hudson Vicinage to Hold Divorce and Post-Divorce Webinars

The Hudson Vicinage will hold a series of free webinars on the divorce process and post-divorce motions on Wednesday, Oct. 6 and Wednesday, Oct. 20. The webinars will be presented by a team consisting of staff from the vicinage's family division, Office of the Ombudsman, and attorneys from Northeast New Jersey Legal Services.

The Oct. 6 divorce process webinar will be from 2 to 3:30 p.m. and the Oct. 20 event will be from 6 to 7:30 p.m. The webinars will assist self-represented litigants filing for a divorce and will provide information on the divorce complaint process and litigants' rights. Vicinage staff will discuss required forms and documentation, the Judiciary Electronic Document Submission (JEDS) system, and what to expect at a divorce hearing.

The same team will discuss motions to change, modify, or enforce a court order in a divorce case on Oct. 6 from 6 to 7:30 p.m. and Oct. 20 from 2 to 3:30 p.m. Information will be provided on the court process when filing a motion, a case information statement, and other court forms.
