## **Monmouth Vicinage to Host the 63<sup>rd</sup> Army Band in Celebration of Veterans Day**

The Monmouth Vicinage will host a virtual Veterans Day program on Wednesday, Nov. 10 from noon to 1 p.m. via Zoom.

The ceremony will be conducted in conjunction with the Tunnel to Towers Foundation and the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans Affairs. The Sea Girt-based 63<sup>rd</sup> Army Band, New Jersey's only National Guard Army Band, will perform. Monmouth Vicinage Superior Court Judge David F. Bauman will preside and give opening and closing remarks.

Marking 20 years since the September 11 terror attacks, the ceremony will honor 9/11-era veterans. Representatives from the Tunnel to Towers Foundation and the New Jersey Department of Military and Veterans Affairs will discuss the nation's global war on terror and programs they provide to veterans. Veterans in the virtual audience will be acknowledged.

We look forward to acknowledging veterans attending the program and to learn more about the mission and efforts of the Tunnel to Towers Foundation and the New Jersey Department of Veterans and Military Affairs,” Assignment Judge Lisa P.
