Hudson Vicinage to Hold Law Day Ceremony

The Hudson Vicinage will hold its annual Law Day ceremony virtually on Tuesday, May 3 at noon.

John Zak of the American Historical Theatre, portraying James Madison, will give the keynote address on this year's national theme, "Toward a More Perfect Union: The Constitution in Times of Change."

As part of the annual Law Day celebration, Hudson County students in grades 6 – 12 competed in art, photography, essay, poetry, and rap contests related to the Law Day theme. The winners, along with the winners of the Hudson County High School Mock Trial competition, will attend the ceremony virtually with their families, principals, and teachers. Awards will be given for each category.

The ceremony also will feature the presentation of the Liberty Bell Award to retired Superior Court Judge Daniel D'Alessandro for his outstanding community service in promoting a better understanding of the rule of law, encouraging greater respect for law and the courts, and inspiring a sense of civic responsibility.

The Law Day celebration is sponsored in partnership with the New Jersey State Bar Association and Foundation and the Hudson County Bar Association and Foundation.

Law Day was established in 1958 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower to celebrate our nation's great heritage of liberty, justice, and equality under law.
