Union Vicinage 2011 Law Day Celebration

The Superior Court of New Jersey, Union Vicinage and the Union County Bar Association will hold their annual Law Day ceremony on Tuesday, May 17, from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the courtroom of Assignment Judge Karen M. Cassidy in Elizabeth.

Judge Cassidy will give the opening remarks. Chief Justice Stuart Rabner will deliver Law Day remarks by video. Members of the bar will present awards to the winners of the Law Day 2011 essay, poetry and poster contests. The Vincent J. Apruzzese Mock Trial Award will be presented to the county champions from Cranford High School. The Charles Hudson School Band will perform, and a member of the New Jersey Orators will deliver a speech.

Union Vicinage will host an information fair in conjunction with its celebration. The information fair will be held on the first floor of the courthouse in the rotunda area from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. All trial divisions, the Union County Clerk's Office and the Union County Office of the Surrogate will be available to answer questions and provide information to the public.

In 1958 President Dwight Eisenhower established Law Day as "a day of national dedication to the principle of government under law." This year's Law Day theme is "The Legacy of John Adams, from Boston to Guantanamo.

The Law Day Program is co-sponsored by the Union Vicinage Advisory Committee on Minority Concerns, the Asian Pacific American Lawyers Association of New Jersey, Garden State Bar Association and Hispanic Bar Association.
