The Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct (ACJC) having presented to the Supreme Court its Findings and Recommendation, filed September 17, 2019, recommending that respondent Carlia M. Brady, Judge of the Superior Court, be removed from judicial office based on the ACJC's findings that respondent violated Canon 1, Rule 1.1, Canon 2, Rule 2.1 and Rule 2.3(A), and Canon 5, Rule 5.1(A) of the Code of Judicial Conduct; and

Respondent having filed a motion for an extension of time within which to file a motion pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 2:15-16 (M-190) and to mark certain exhibits from the ACJC proceedings confidential (M-191), and good cause appearing; it is

ORDERED that respondent's motion for an extension of time is granted, in part. Respondent may serve and file a motion pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 2:15-16 on or before October 16, 2019. Any answer to respondent's forthcoming motion shall be served and filed on or before October 29, 2019. The Court will hear oral argument on respondent's motion on November 12, 2019, at 2:00 p.m.

It is further ORDERED that respondent's motion to mark as confidential certain exhibits from the ACJC proceedings (M-191), is granted.
