The Chief Justice has requested me to advise you that in all criminal cases arrangements should be made for exhibits delivered to the court by the Attorney General or a prosecutor to be appropriately safeguarded while in the possession of the court and to be returned only to a representative of the Attorney General or Prosecutor, and not to be entrusted to 504 Enterprises, Lawyers Service, or the mails for delivery. An appropriate receipt should be given both upon the receipt and delivery of exhibits.
