1. The Chief Justice has requested me to advise the Chairs of all Supreme Court Committees that meetings of all committees of trial judges and members should be so scheduled as not to conflict with regular court hours. Your cooperation in this regard will be appreciated.
2. If any dinner meetings of a committee are to be held at the expense of the State, it is essential for budgetary reasons that this office be advised in advance. All meetings are to be held at the Justice Complex or the New Jersey State Bar Association Law Center with arrangements made by the Administrative Office of Courts. Any exception to this policy requires advance approval of the Administrative Office of the Courts. Arrangements for billing are to be submitted directly to the Administrative Office of the Courts on the appropriate voucher.

EDITOR-S NOTE

In the text of the first paragraph the only change has been the insertion of the intended addressees, chairs of all Supreme Court Committees.

In the second paragraph the use of restaurant or clubs for meetings has been deleted to conform to the new 1991 policy permitting such meetings only at the Justice Complex or the New Jersey State Bar Association Law Center.
