

## Firearms

The Attorney General requests that in appeals taken pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4e* from the denial of a permit to purchase firearms or pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 2C:58-3d* from the denial of a permit to carry a pistol or revolver, notice of the date set for hearing be given (a) to the County Prosecutor if the denial was by the Chief of Police of a municipality, or (b) to the Attorney General if the denial was by the Superintendent of the State Police.

Your cooperation in giving such notice in these matters will be appreciated.
