Wage Execution C Proof of Service of Notice

It appears that some judges are requiring additional proof of service of notice of wage executions other than the attorneys' certifications. After a review of this issue the Supreme Court has concluded that a certification by the attorney that a notice to the judgment debtor of wage execution has been mailed by certified mail is sufficient. Accordingly, green cards or returned certified envelopes shall not be required to support the issuance of a wage execution.

EDITOR=S NOTE

This issue of proof of service of a notice of wage execution was reviewed by the former Supreme Court Committee on County District Courts and it was its recommendation which was adopted by this directive. Although the original directive was addressed to the former Presiding Judges of County District Courts and to the district court clerks, the policy is generally applicable to all courts. All references to the former County District Courts have been removed.
