- 5. On May 27, 2004 and again on September 29, 2004, checks in the amount of \$500 each were issued from the Firm's business account, under the signature of Martin T. Durkin, to the Edgewater Democratic Campaign Fund.

6.	On January 12, 2005, a check in the amount of \$600 was issued from the Firm's
business acco	unt, under the signature of Martin T. Durkin, to the Bergen County Democratic
Organization.
