The Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct having filed a presentment with the Court in respect of WILSON J. CAMPBELL, formerly a Judge of the Municipal Court of Jersey City, finding by clear and convincing evidence that he violated Canon 1 (a judge should personally observe high standards of conduct so the integrity and independence of the judiciary may be preserved) and Canon 2A (a judge should respect and comply with the law and act at all times in a manner that promotes public confidence in the integrity and impartiality of the judiciary) of the Code of Judicial Conduct; Rule 2:15-8(a)(6)(a judge should not engage in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice that brings the judicial office into disrepute); and the Judiciary's Equal Employment Opportunity policy;

And the Committee having recommended that respondent be publicly reprimanded for his misconduct;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that pursuant to $\underline{\text{Rule}}$ 2:15-17(b)(2), **WILSON J. CAMPBELL**, formerly a Judge of the Municipal Court of Jersey City, shall show cause before this Court why he should not be publicly

disciplined through the imposition of an appropriate sanction that does not include removal from judicial office; and it is further

ORDERED that Candace Moody, Esquire, shall present this matter to the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the parties shall file briefs on this Order to Show Cause, with respondent's brief to be served and filed on or before May 11, 2010, and the presenter's brief to be served and filed on or before June 7, 2010; and it is further

ORDERED that the matter shall be set down for oral argument on June 15, 2010, at $2:00~\rm p.m.$, in the Supreme Court Courtroom, Hughes Justice Complex, Trenton.
