


STIPULATIONS

The undersigned Disciplinary Counsel ("Presenter") to the Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct and Wilson J. Campbell, former judge of the Jersey City Municipal Court ("Respondent"), through counsel, hereby enter into these Stipulations:

1. Respondent is a member of the Bar of the State of New Jersey, having been admitted to the practice of law in 1999.
2. At all times relevant to this matter, Respondent served as a part-time judge in the Jersey City Municipal Court.
3. Respondent resigned his position as a part-time judge in the Jersey City Municipal Court, effective October 23, 2009.
4. For approximately three months, beginning in the spring of 2008 and concluding on June 26, 2008, Respondent was engaged in an intimate relationship with A.K., a bailiff in the Jersey City Municipal Court.
5. During her intimate relationship with Respondent, A.K. was assigned and served as Respondent's bailiff.
6. Throughout the duration of their intimate relationship, Respondent did not notify his superiors of the existence of his relationship with A.K.
