The Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct having filed with the Court pursuant to Rule 2:15-15(a), a presentment recommending that Hector I. Rodriguez, a former Judge of the Municipal Court, be publicly reprimanded for violating Canon 1, Rule 1.1 (requires judges to "participate in establishing, maintaining and enforcing, and . . . [to] personally observe, high standards of conduct so [as to preserve] . . . the integrity, impartiality and independence of the judiciary"); Canon 2, Rule 2.1 (requires judges to "act at all times in a manner that promotes public confidence in the independence, integrity and impartiality of the judiciary, and . . . [to] avoid impropriety and the appearance of impropriety"); and Canon 3, Rule 3.5 (requires judges to be patient, dignified, and courteous to litigants, jurors, witnesses, lawyers and others with whom the judge deals in an official capacity) of the Code of Judicial Conduct:

And the Court having ordered respondent to show cause why he should not be publicly disciplined through the imposition of an appropriate sanction that does not include removal from judicial office;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that the findings and recommendation of the Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct are adopted and **Hector I. Rodriguez**, a former Judge of the Municipal Court, is hereby publicly reprimanded.
