Committee on Judicial Conduct and having waived his right to the issuance of an Order to Show Cause and a hearing before the Supreme Court;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that the findings and recommendation of the Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct are adopted and EMERY Z.

TOTH, Judge of the Municipal Court of the Borough of South River, is hereby publicly reprimanded.
