<p>Additional Information Regarding State Police Expungement Status Portal: After a judge signs your granted expungement order, the order will be transmitted to law enforcement agencies who are responsible for removing expunged records from their files. One of those law enforcement agencies is the New Jersey State Police (NJSP), which is responsible for removing expunged criminal complaints from the Computerized Criminal History (CCH) system that the NJSP uses to respond to criminal history background checks. The NJSP maintains its own Expungement Status Portal for you to track whether it has processed your expungement order. You can sign up for an account to access the NJSP Expungement Status Portal and track your expungement order by visiting https://expungement.njsp.gov/.
