<p><b>Additional Information Regarding State Police Expungement Status Portal:</b> After a judge signs your granted expungement order, the order will be transmitted to law enforcement agencies who are responsible for removing expunged records from their files. One of those law enforcement agencies is the New Jersey State Police (NJSP), which is responsible for removing expunged criminal complaints from the Computerized Criminal History (CCH) system that the NJSP uses to respond to criminal history background checks. The NJSP maintains its own Expungement Status Portal for you to track whether it has processed your expungement order. You can sign up for an account to access the NJSP Expungement Status Portal and track your expungement order by visiting <a href="https://expungement.njsp.gov/">https://expungement.njsp.gov/</a>. ## Duplicate Cases in Financial Obligation Section

The system will check for any duplicate Case IDs in the 'Financial obligations/Restitution Details' in the 'Proposed Order' and 'Judicial Decision' screens. If any duplicate cases are found it will display an error message as shown in Figure 10. The system will only allow you to proceed with the petition after you de-select or remove the duplicate case.



## Expungement Notifications Workbasket Updates

In the Expungement Notifications workbasket search window, 'Court/Division' is a newly added search parameter, and your division will be selected by default.

For users who have multiple division access, they will be able to select a specific division to search cases.

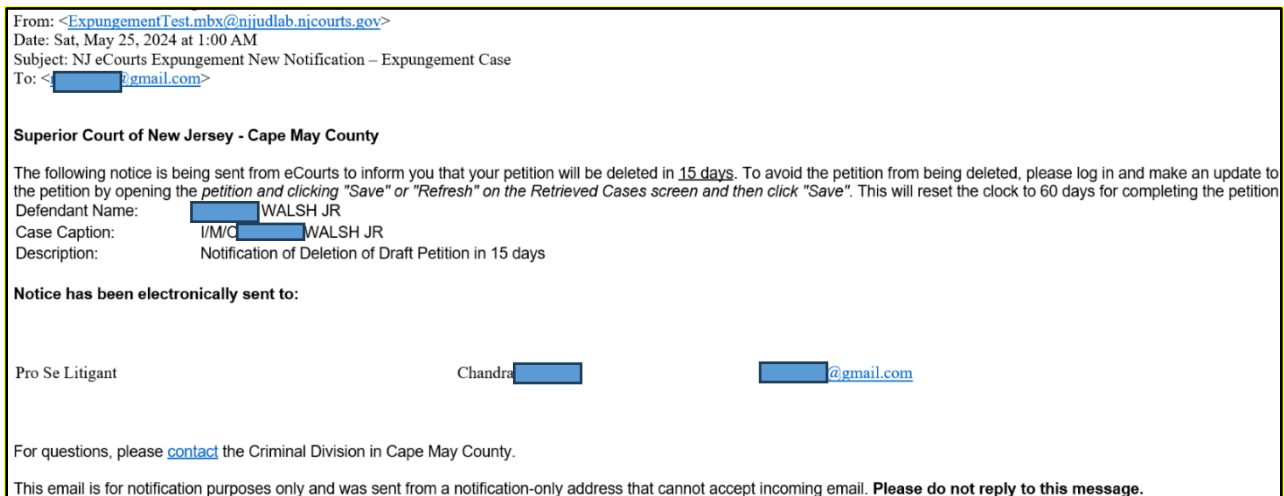
## Email to Users that Petitions in New Status Will be Deleted After 60 Days of Inactivity

For petitions in 'New' or 'Draft Amended Order' status that have not been updated or submitted within 45 days, the system will trigger an email to the petitioner/filer stating that it will be deleted in 15 days.

**Note:** Per current functionality, Expungement petitions that have not been submitted nor have an Expungement case number, will be deleted from the system after 60 days of inactivity from the date of initial creation.

To reset the 60-day timer, the user can open the petition and click 'Save.' Once this is done, it will reset the timer and after 45 days of inactivity, a new email will be triggered.

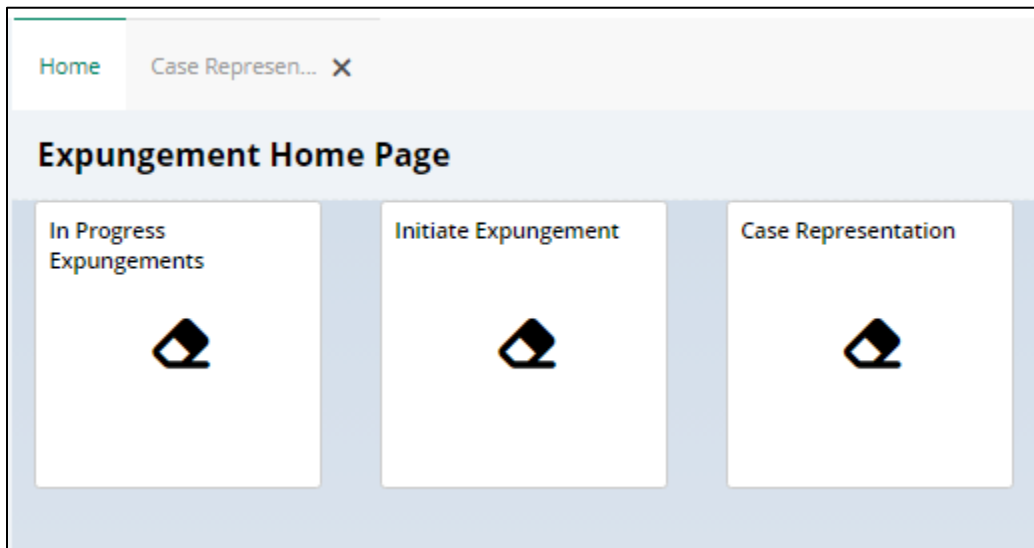


## *Attorneys Can Now Associate Themselves to an Expungement Case*



## *County and Central Public Defender Notification Emails*

County and Central Public Defenders will receive an email when they file an expungement, when a petition is returned, and various events about the case. Notification emails will be stored in the Case Jacket to review. The following are the events that trigger an email notification:

- Expungement Petition Filed or Revised
- Amended Expungement Petition is Filed or Revised
- Prosecutor submits a response to the Petition or an Amended Proposed Order
- Prosecutor returns the Petition to the Petitioner or an Amended Proposed Order
- Court Staff/Judge provides a Judicial Decision
- Court Staff/Judge provides a Granted Judicial Decision for Amended Order
- A Petition is Withdrawn
- Court Staff modifies the case status from "Pending Prosecutor review" to "Pending Petitioner Response"
- Court Staff modifies the case status from "Revised Petition Prosecutor Review" to "Pending Petitioner Response"
- Hearing Date Scheduled

## Self-Represented Litigant's (Pro Se) Process Flow Updates


Self-represented litigants will now retain their submitted expungement petitions once returned by the Prosecutor, unless they consent to allow the County Public Defender to represent them on the expungement case. If a prosecutor returns the petition, the self-represented litigant will see the 'Open' button enabled and be able to work on the petition.

On the Verification screen, a self-represented litigant will be able to select an option consenting to allow County Public Defender to handle the expungement petition if the petition is returned by the Prosecutor. By selecting the checkbox, the County Public Defender can assign themselves to the case if the petition is returned.

The compelling circumstances for the Court to grant this expungement are as follows:'
  - 'The petitioner is seeking an expungement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:52-2(c)(3) of a third or fourth degree controlled dangerous substance crime. The compelling circumstances for the Court to grant this expungement are as follows:'
  - 'I am seeking expungement of a dismissal of a criminal charge because of acceptance into a supervisory treatment or other diversion program, and that the information presented in the petition as to those charges sets forth the nature of the original charge, the court of disposition and the date of disposition.'
- Representation by Public Defender if Petition is Returned:** A checked checkbox with the text: 'If the Prosecutor returns the petition, I consent to the Office of the Public Defender entering their appearance to assist with a response. There will be no fee associated with this representation.'

If the petition is returned, email notifications are sent to the corresponding County Public Defender's generic email as well as the self-represented litigant with the consent, either yes or no, and contact information so the County Public Defender can contact the user regarding their expungement petition.

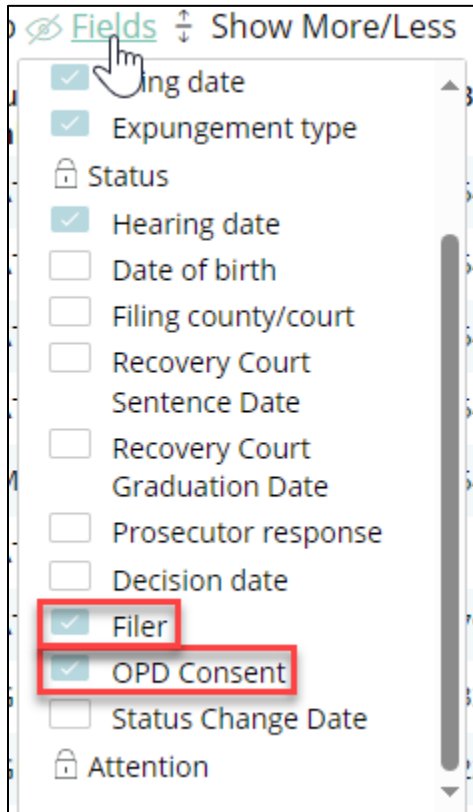

**Figure 14. New Workbasket Fields**

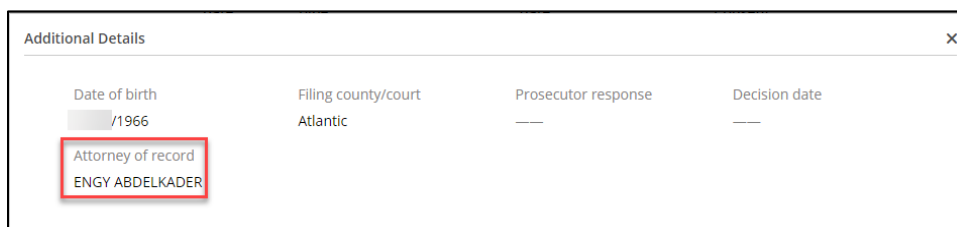


**Figure 15. Fields added to the Columns of the Workbasket**

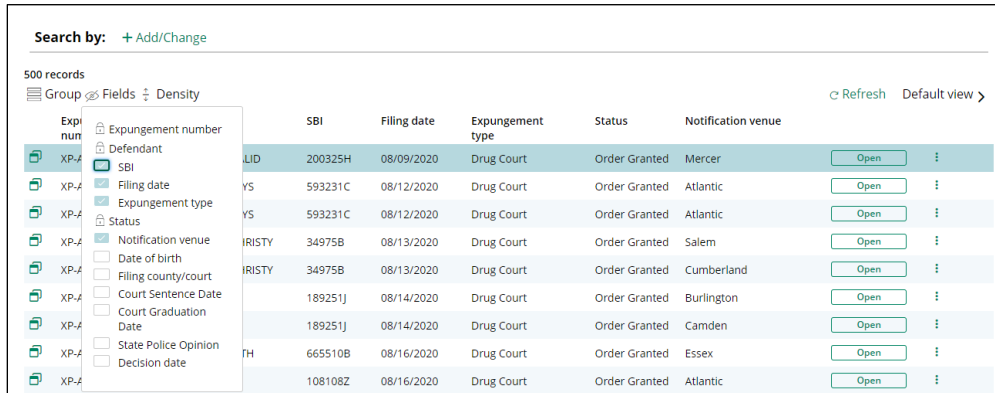
**Figure 1 – Adding groups**

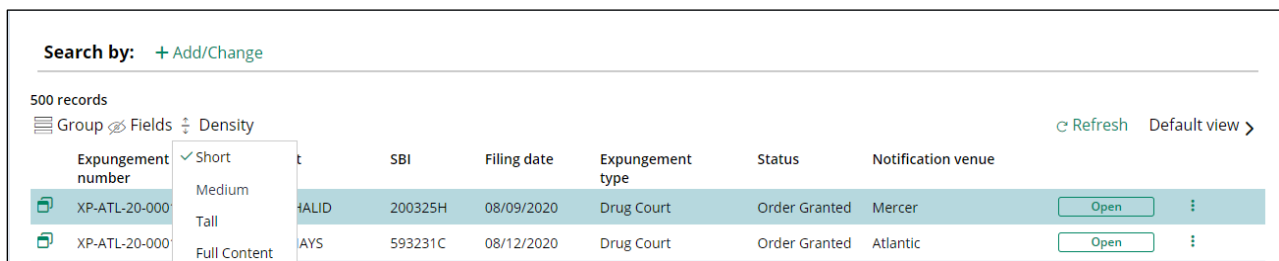

**Figure 2 – Adding Fields to the Grid**



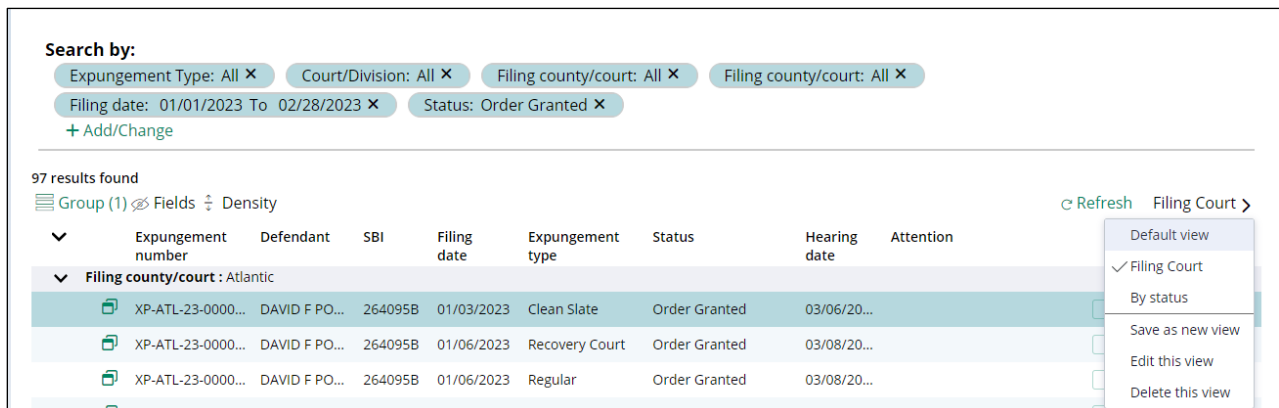

Additional changes have been made to the screen table flows (Retrieved Cases, Additional Cases, Case List, and Initiate Expungement) as well. One notable change has been that the expandable twisty has been replaced with the modal window,  , icon which when clicked displays the existing fields in a modal window.

### *Workbasket Default Display Update*

Expungement cases from the **default In-Progress workbasket** and notification from the **default Notification workbasket** will be archived after seven (7) days from the date of the decision. You will still be able to search for the archived cases based on certain conditions.

For Pro Se users, cases will never be removed from the default workbasket.

On the In-Progress workbasket, cases in 'Order Denied', 'Withdrawn', 'Dismissed', 'Order Granted' or 'Amended Order Granted' will be **removed from the default workbasket after 7 days**. Private attorneys will still be able to search for cases filed by the firm. County Public Defenders and County Prosecutors will still be able to search for cases associated to their office. They will still be able to search for the cases statewide.

For County Public Defenders and County Prosecutors, cases in 'Order Denied', 'Withdrawn', 'Dismissed', 'Order Granted' or 'Amended Order Granted' will be removed from the default workbasket after 7 days. They will still be able to search for cases associated to their office. They will still be able to search for the cases statewide.

On the Notification workbasket, expungement notifications will be removed immediately after the case is updated to 'Expunged', 'Reviewed' or 'Reviewed Vacated Order' status. They can still be searched for indefinitely if they were received in their workbasket.



**Figure 5 – View Notified Agencies**





**Figure 1 – Expungement Case Number Search**





## Expungement Petition Status Change

Court Staff and Judges can now modify the **Case Status** when the Status is “Pending Prosecutor Review”, “Revised Petition Prosecutor Review”, “Pending Petitioner Response”, and “Awaiting Judicial Decision”.

Statuses can be updated as follows:

- From Pending Prosecutor Review, the status can be updated to Pending Petitioner Response or Awaiting Judicial Decision.
- From Revised Petition Prosecutor Review, the status can be updated to Pending Petitioner Review or Awaiting Judicial Decision.
- From Pending Petitioner Response, the status can be updated to Revised Petition Prosecutor Review or Awaiting Judicial Decision.
- From Awaiting Judicial Decision the status can be updated to Revised Petition Prosecutor Review, Pending Prosecutor Review or Pending Petitioner Response.

When Court staff changes the status, a case jacket entry will be added denoting the change. When the status is changed to Pending Petitioner Response, an email notification will be sent to the petitioner (private attorney or to the County Public Defender general mailbox if it was initiated by a self-represented litigant).

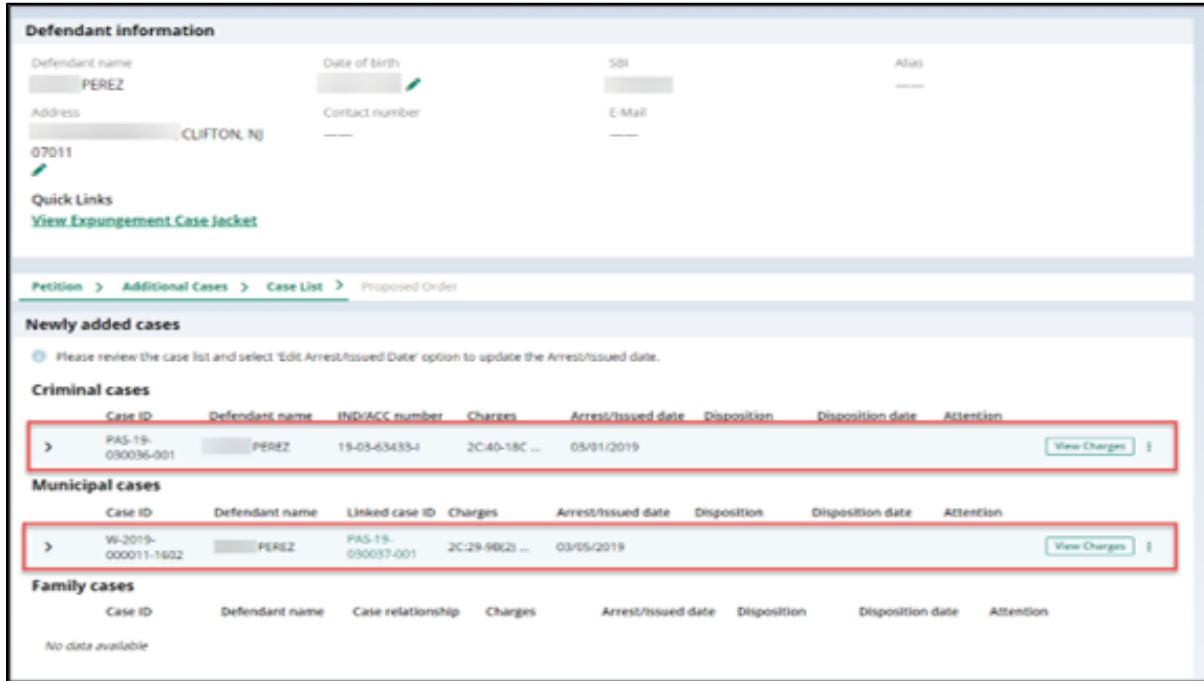

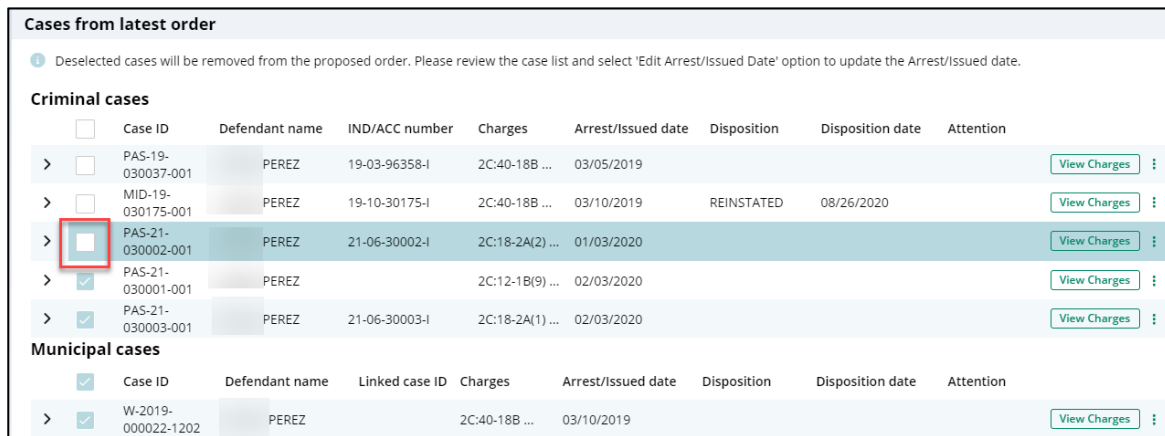

Unchecked cases will be removed from the proposed amended expungement order but can be added back if the proposed amended order is returned to you (the petitioner). The expungement types this applies to are **Regular**, **Clean Slate**, and **Recovery Court. Marijuana** and **Marijuana Decriminalization** expungements follow the original flow and are submitted to the Court without Prosecutor review.

The **Proposed Order** screen displays a new field for the **Amendment Reason**. The Amendment Reason text must be added and will be displayed on the Proposed Amended Order PDF. Notified agencies from prior order as well as parties/agencies from the newly added cases will be displayed under listed Notified agencies, but additional Notified agencies can be added manually by using “Other applicable party(ies)” option. Financial obligations/Restitution Details can also be added as applicable.

After submission, the status will change to **Amended Order Prosecutor Review**, or **Amended Order Judicial Decision (for Marijuana and Marijuana Decriminalization expungement types only)**. When you save an Amend Order without submitting, the status changes to **Draft Amended Order**. If an Amend Order is returned by the Prosecutor, the status will change to **Amended Order Petitioner Response**. Once an Amend Order is granted the status will update to **Amended Order Granted**.

An additional status of Amended Order Prosecutor Review is added to the County Prosecutor’s workbasket. The process is the same as the normal expungement petition filing process. County Prosecutors will see the Case List screen and Response screen. Prosecutors can object to the Amended Order and add comments on charges. The Response narrative field becomes mandatory if an objection is entered and/or if the petition is being returned to the petitioner.

## Proposed Order and Prosecutor Response Screen Updates

The Proposed Order screen has been updated such that the Preview Proposed Order and Preview Petition buttons are moved to a new location on the screen. The buttons are required and the "Submit" button will remain greyed out until the button(s) are clicked.

On a Regular, Clean Slate, and Recovery Court expungement, both Preview Proposed Order and Preview Petition buttons are required.



## A Hearing Date Will Be Automatically Set When Certain Expungement Petitions are Submitted

A hearing date will automatically be set when a Recovery Court, Regular or Clean Slate expungement petition/proposed order is submitted by a petitioner.

The hearing date will be set to a business day 60 days after the filing date. The hearing date **will not** be added to a calendar (ECS).

**Note:** The initial hearing date is calculated one day after the filing date + 60 days. It cannot fall on a weekend or Judicial holiday.

Court Staff will have the ability to reschedule the hearing date as needed.

The **Actual Hearing Date** label has been changed to read-only field **Hearing Date** on the Judicial Decision screen.

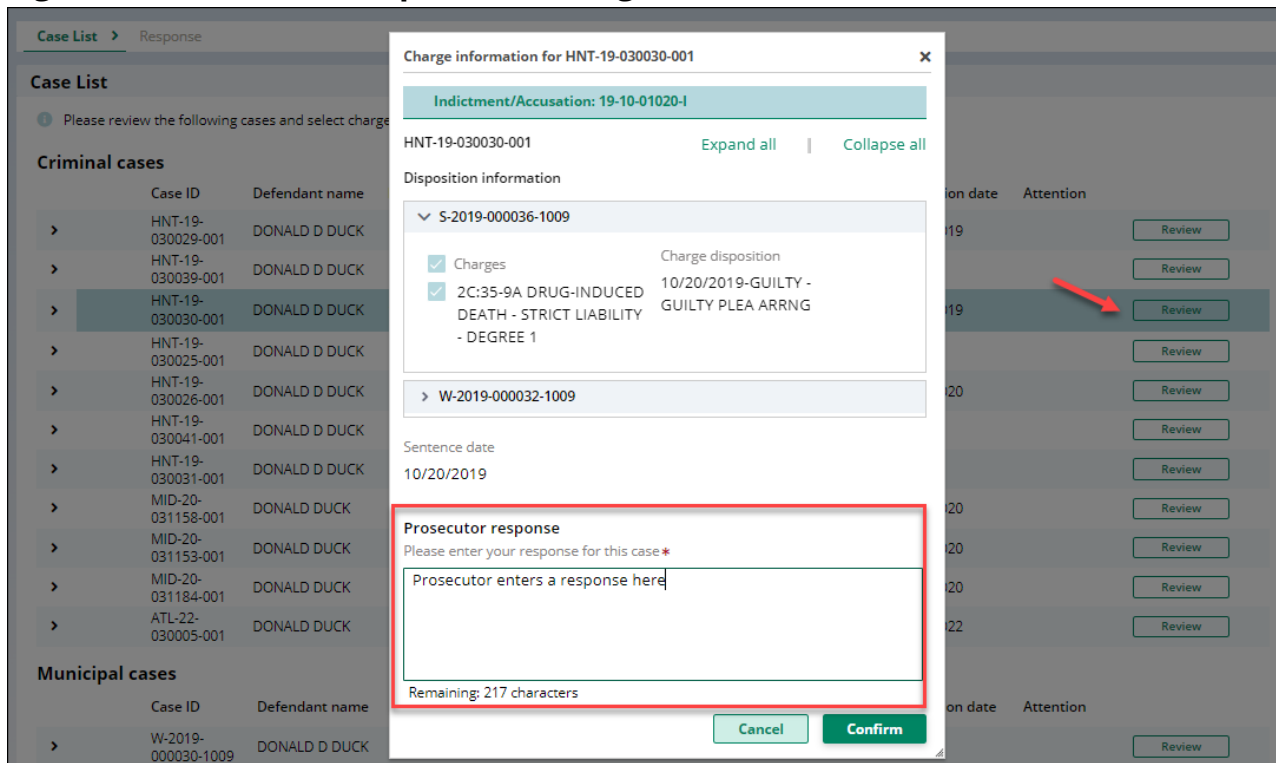
**Figure 4 – Prosecutor has no objection and submits to the Court**



**Figure 16 - Petitioner submit option after third prosecutor return**





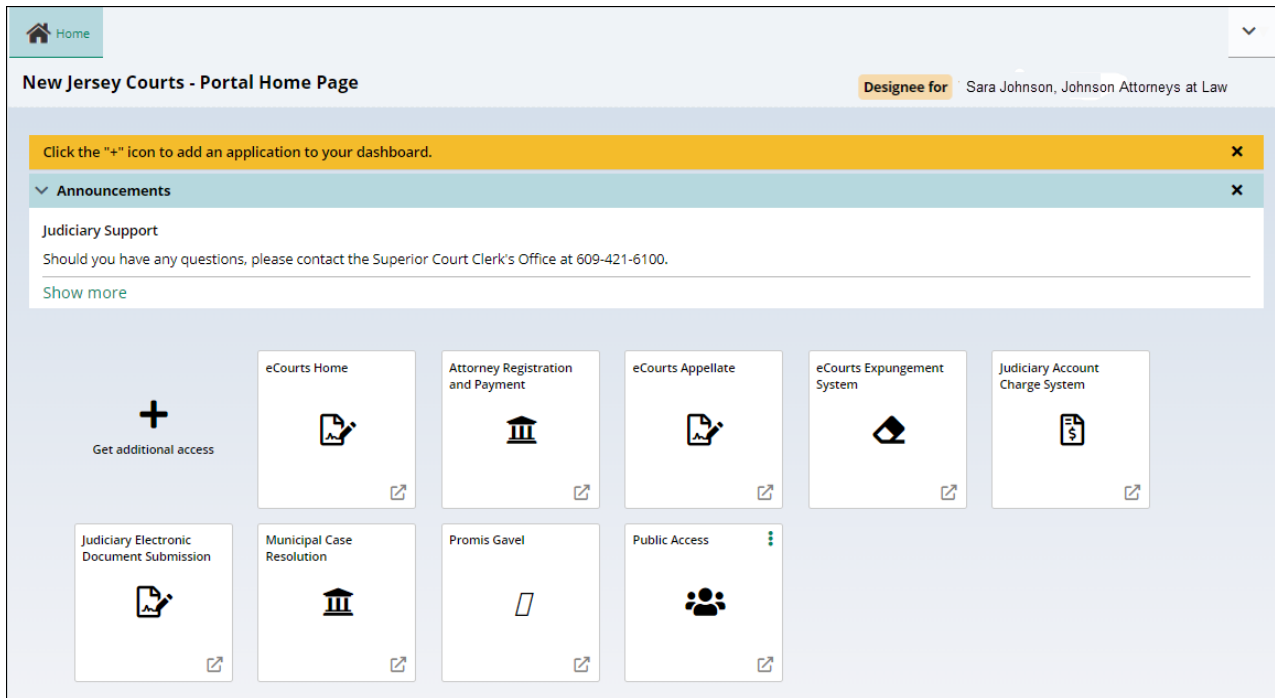

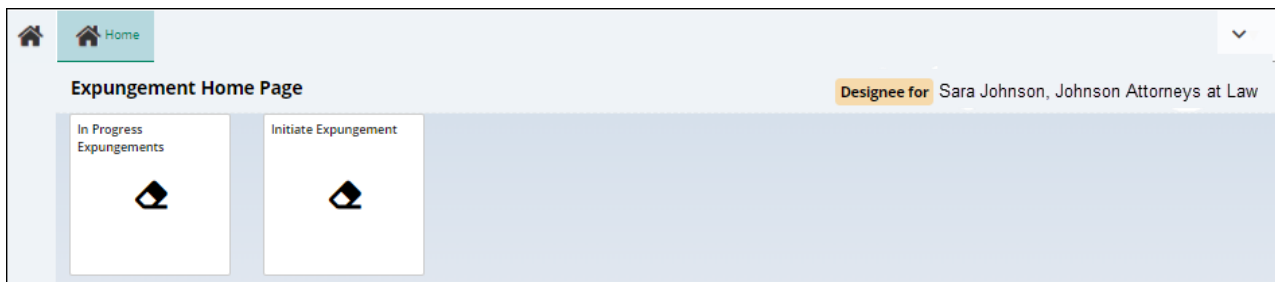



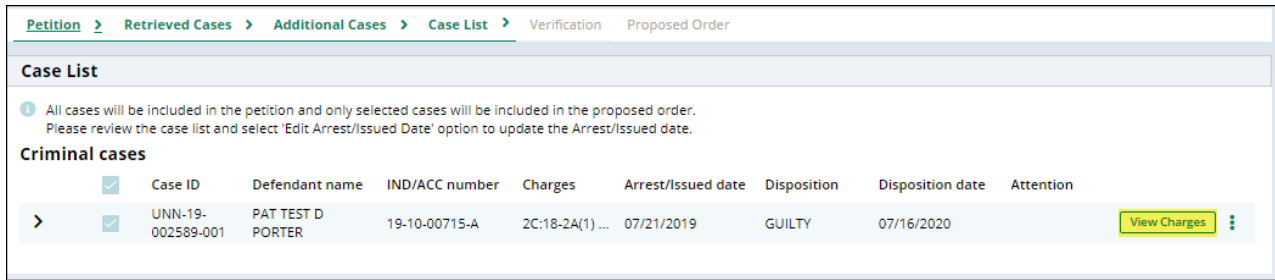
**Figure 1 – View Charges button on the Retrieved cases screen**

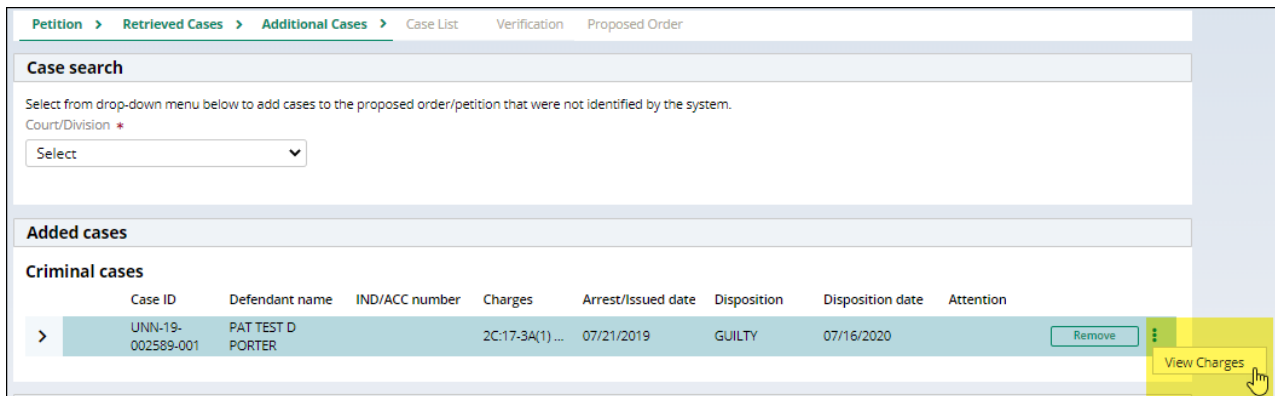

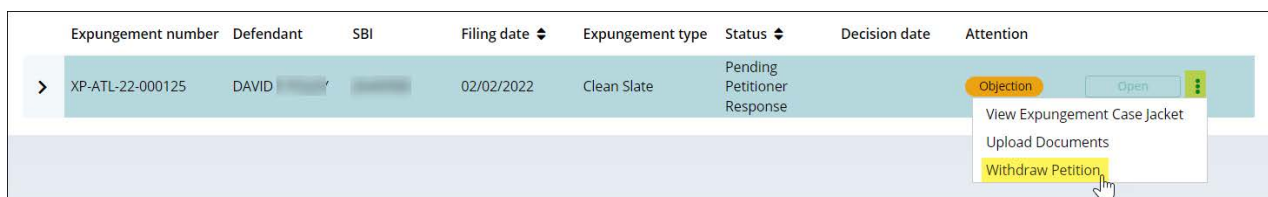

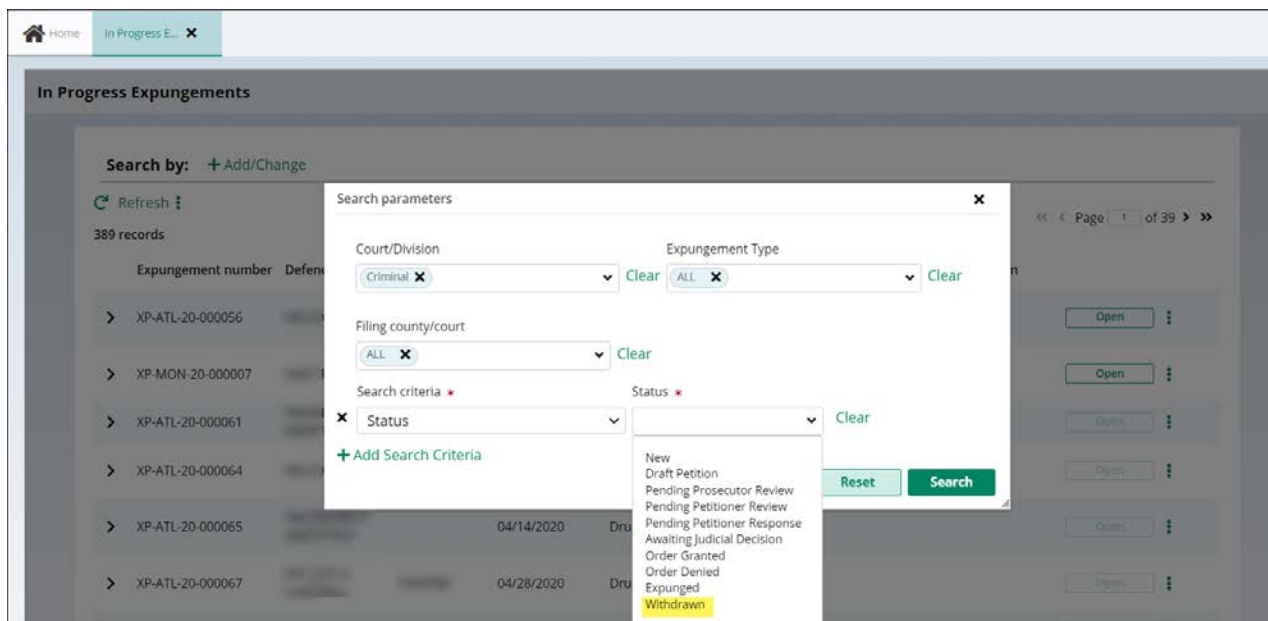

*Unclassifiable Charges Section for Criminal, Municipal and Family Added to PCH Report*

The PCH report now displays new sections called **Unclassifiable Charges** for each division – Criminal, Municipal and Family. The purpose of this section is to display any cases that do not fit the criteria to be included in the Pending Charges, Prior Convictions, or Non-Conviction sections within a division.

Example: A Criminal case (Promis/Gavel) was remanded to municipal court; however the associated complaint number pre-dates the ACS system, therefore, it will not be displayed in the Municipal division of the report. In this scenario, the P/G case and corresponding complaint number will be displayed under **Criminal Unclassifiable Charges** section.



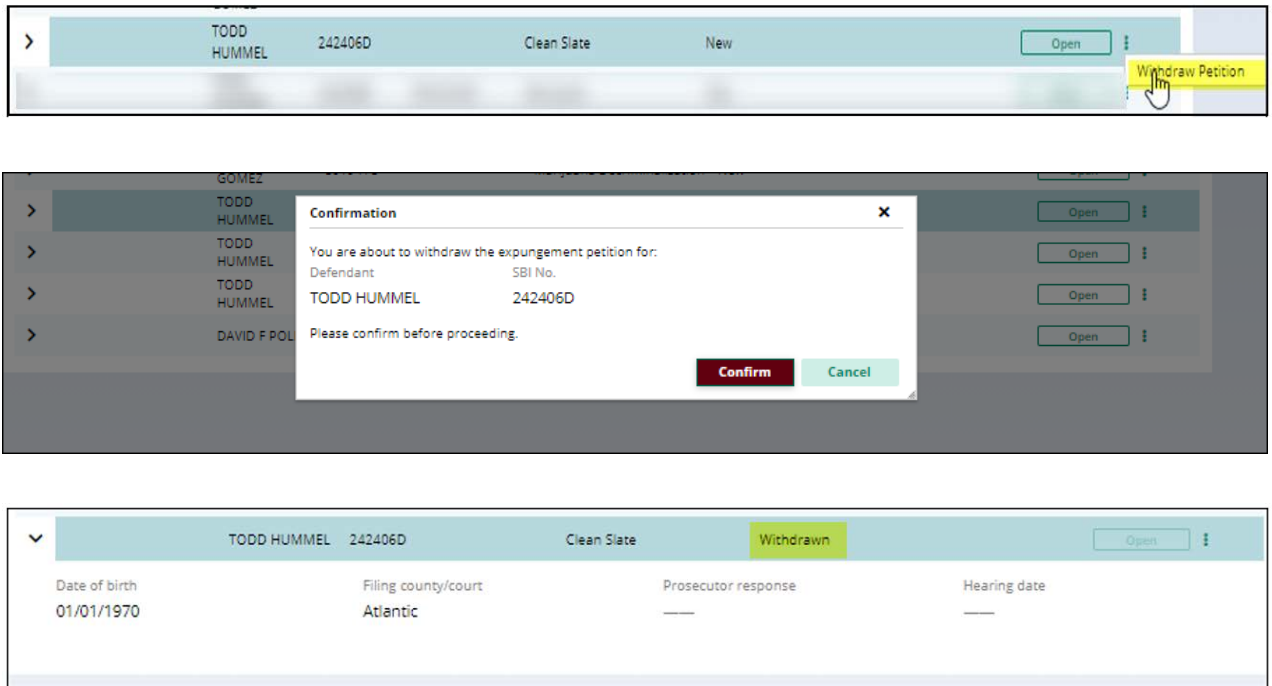



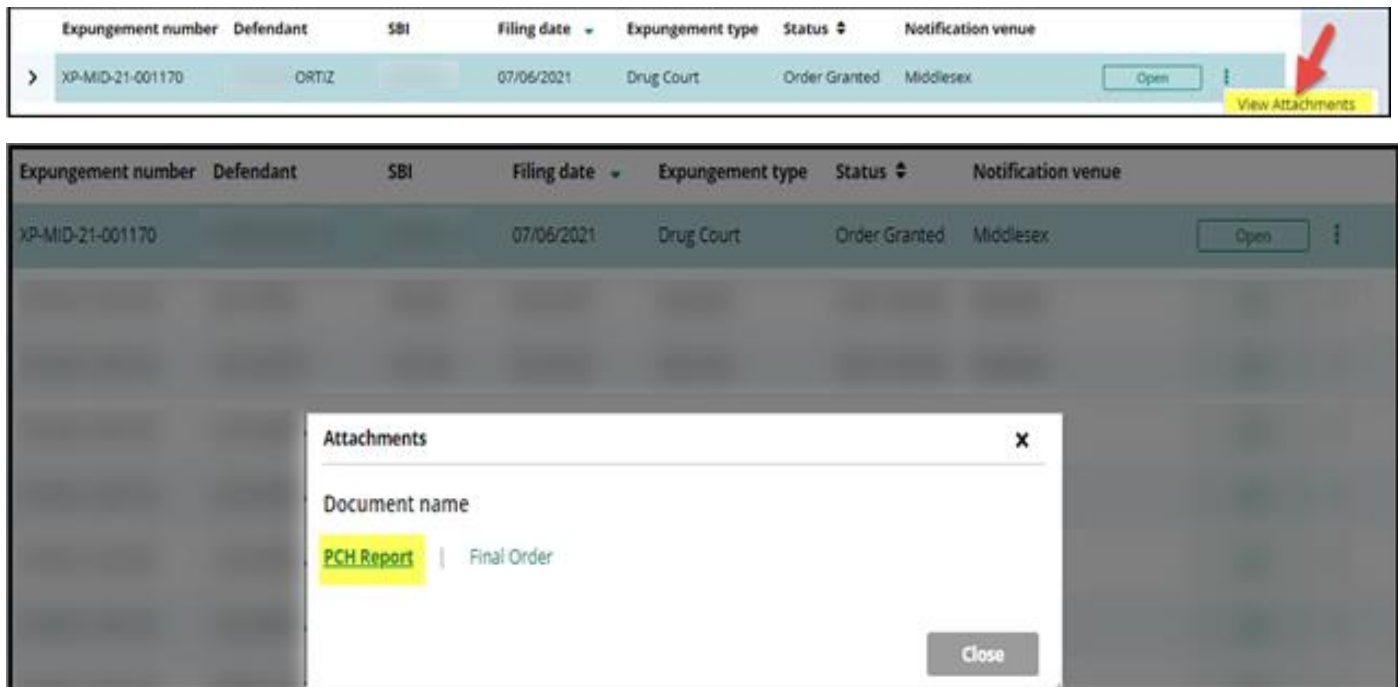





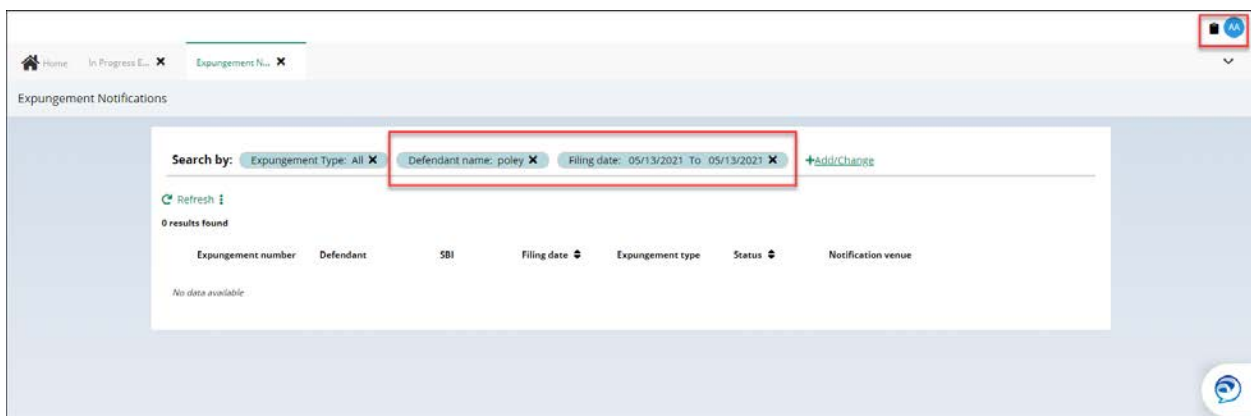

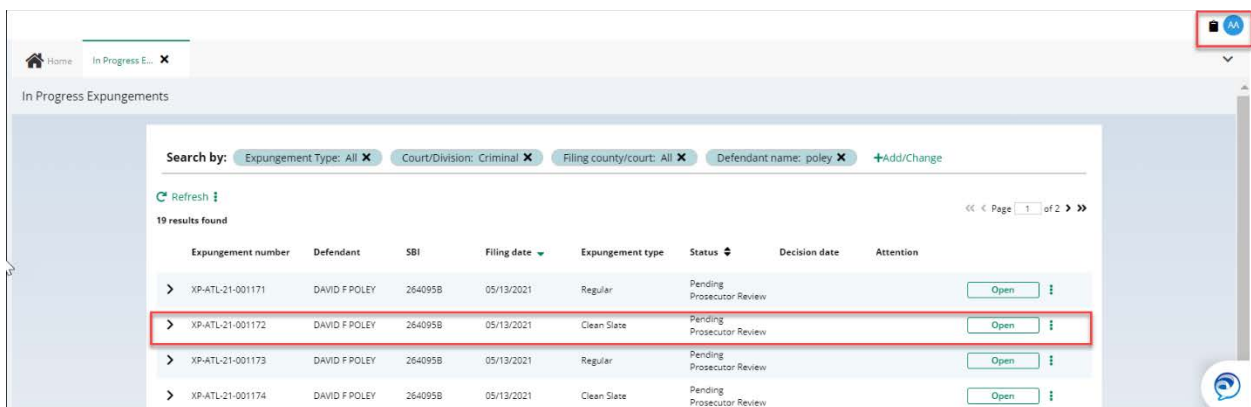




**Figure 1 – Workbasket Menu – View Notification Status**

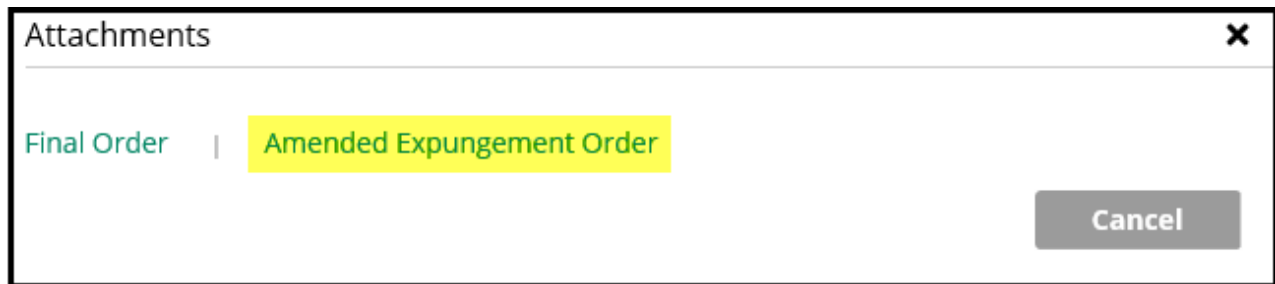







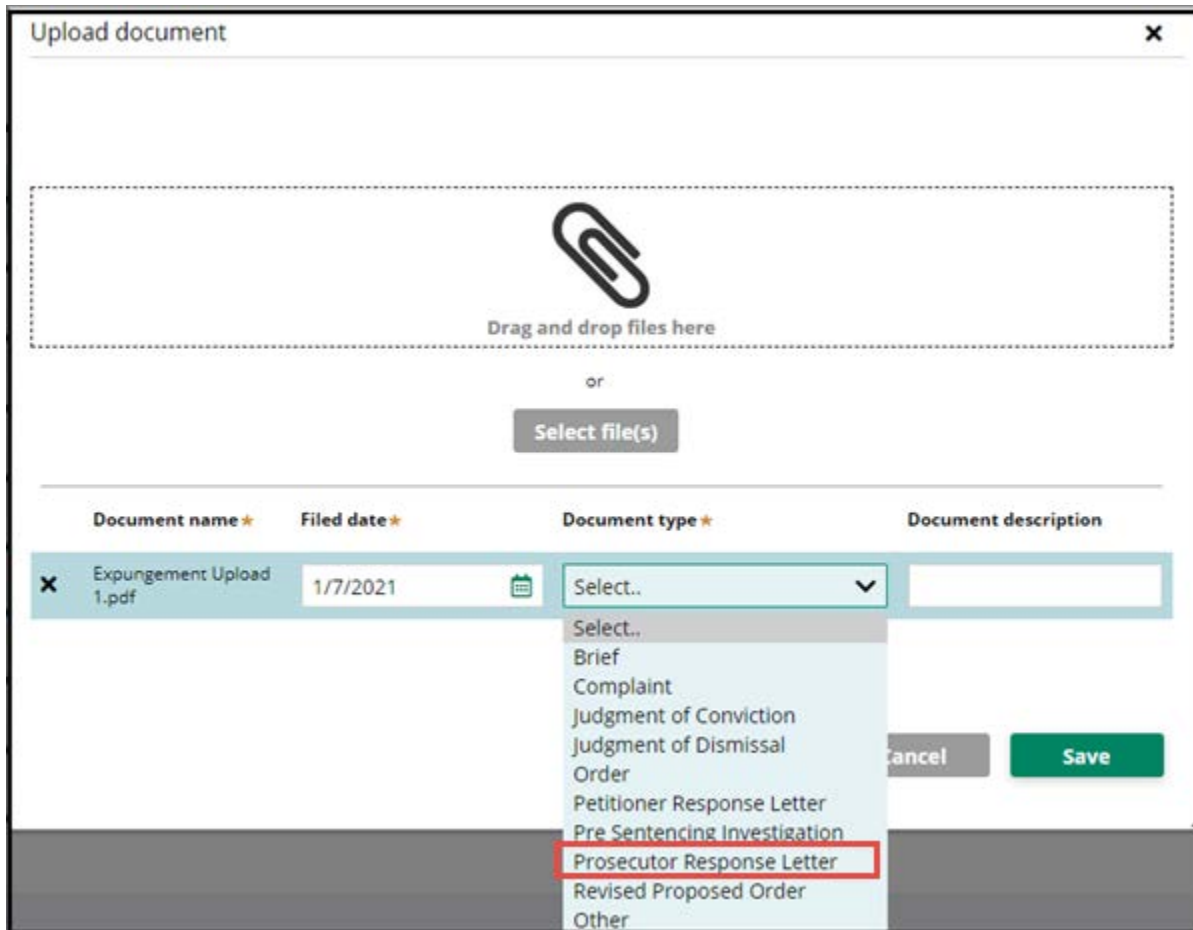

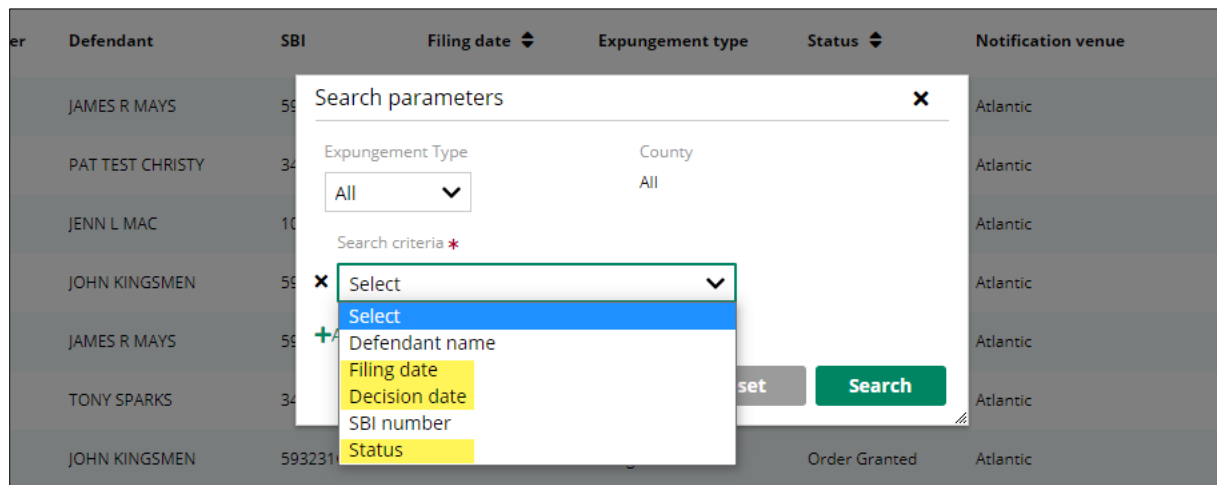

**Figure 1 – Updated Search Criteria Values for Expungement Notifications Workbasket**



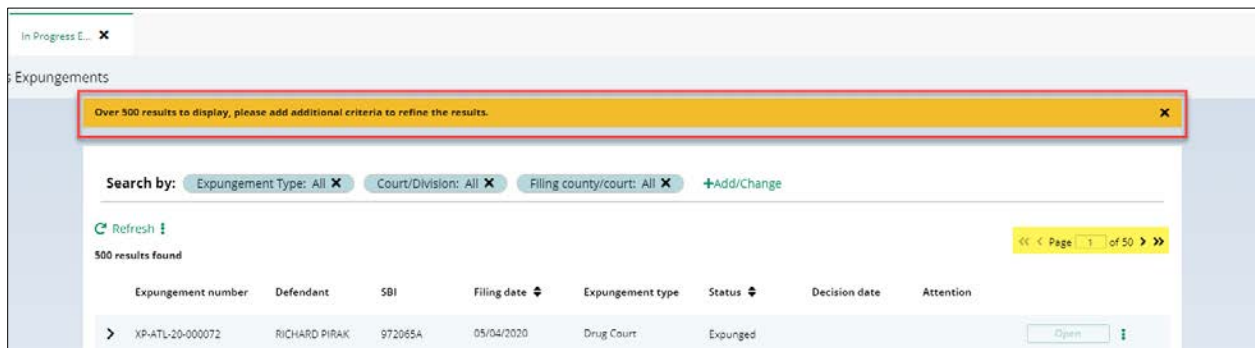
