¹ Under N.J.S.A. 2C:39-13, the above offenses, and attempts to commit them, are enumerated offenses under the Act. However, if the court has charged the jury on lesser offenses, such as theft, they should be included in the list of offenses. A finding by the jury that a defendant wore a body vest to commit a non-enumerated offense would result in a judgment of acquittal.
