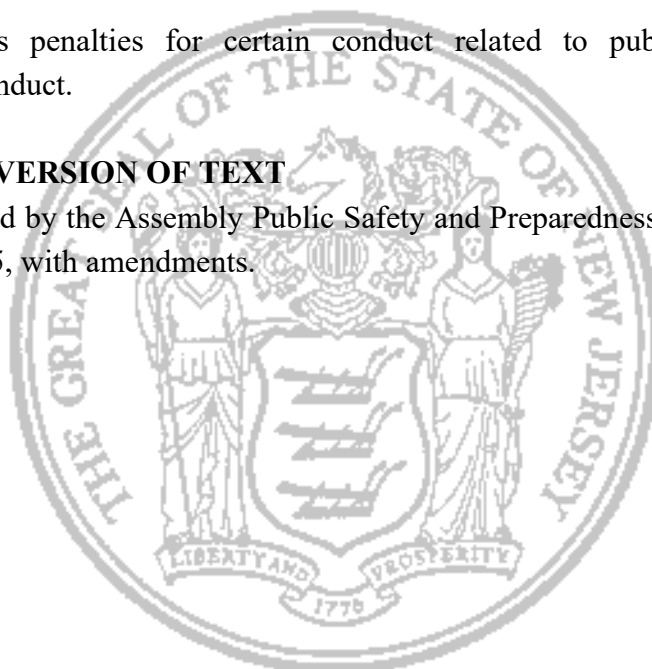

Establishes penalties for certain conduct related to public brawl and disorderly conduct.

1 AN ACT concerning public brawls and disorderly conduct and
2 supplementing Title 2C of the New Jersey Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. A parent or legal guardian having legal custody of a juvenile
8 shall be:

9 a. subject to a fine of \$1,000, to be collected in a civil action
10 by a summary proceeding under the "Penalty Enforcement Law of
11 1999," P.L.1999, c.274 (C.2A:58-10 et seq.), if the parent or legal
12 guardian demonstrated willful or wanton disregard in the exercise
13 of the supervision and control of the conduct of the juvenile such
14 that the juvenile was adjudicated delinquent for engaging in
15 improper behavior in violation of subsection a. of N.J.S.2C:33-2,
16 which resulted in property damage;

17 b. guilty of a petty disorderly persons offense if the parent or
18 legal guardian demonstrated willful or wanton disregard in the
19 exercise of the supervision and control of the conduct of the
20 juvenile such that the juvenile was adjudicated delinquent for a first
21 offense of inciting a public brawl in violation of subsection c. of
22 N.J.S.2C:33-1; and

23 c. guilty of a disorderly persons offense if the parent or legal
24 guardian demonstrated willful or wanton disregard in the exercise
25 of the supervision and control of the conduct of the juvenile and the
26 juvenile was adjudicated delinquent for a second or subsequent
27 offense of inciting a public brawl in violation of subsection c. of
28 N.J.S.2C:33-1.

30 2. This act shall take effect ¹**【**upon the enactment into law of
31 P.L. , c. (C.) (pending before the Legislature as Senate Bill
32 No. 3508 of 2024-2025)**】** immediately¹.
