The Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage Ombudsman staff and representatives from Legal Services of New Jersey (LSNJ) and South Jersey Legal Services (SJLS) will present an informational seminar to assist self-represented litigants who are filing for an expungement application. A brief overview of the Judiciary's eCourts expungement system will be discussed.

Attorneys from LSNJ and SJLS will provide information on the current laws and procedures when filing for an expungement. LSNJ and SJLS will review the application form and discuss what happens after an expungement has been granted. Ombudsman Office staff will be available to answer questions regarding the applications and court processes.
