Write an essay that describes the individual liberty(ies) that you feel are most in need of protection from governmental oppression. Discuss how the Constitution protects those liberties.

- EACH SCHOOL IS LIMITED TO 10 ENTRIES PER GRADE.
- The essay must clearly address the topic and cannot exceed 300 words.

- Submissions must include the student's name, grade, school, teacher's name and email.

DEADLINE: Essays must be received by April 22, 2022.
