INSTRUCCIONES PARA PRESENTAR UN PEDIMENTO EN EL TRIBUNAL DE ASUNTOS TRIBUTARIOS

- Se debe presentar un pedimento si necesita que el Tribunal de Asuntos Tributarios tome una acción formal antes del juicio. La práctica de pedimentos en el Tribunal de Asuntos Tributarios está regulada por la *Regla 8:7* de las Reglas que Rigen los Tribunales de Nueva Jersey. Consulte también la *Regla 1:6-3* para obtener información sobre los plazos de presentación y la notificación de pedimentos y pedimentos en contra.
- Al presentar un pedimento, debe incluir los siguientes documentos originales (incluidos en este paquete):
 - Aviso de Pedimento (*Notice of Motion*)
 - Certificación en Apoyo del Pedimento (*Certification in Support of Motion*)
 - Certificación de Notificación (*Certification of Service*)
 - Formulario propuesto de Orden (*Proposed form of Order*)
- Los pedimentos deben ser presentadas directamente ante el juez asignado a su caso. Si su demanda aún no ha sido asignada a un juez, el pedimento debe presentarse ante el juez asignado al área geográfica donde se encuentra su propiedad. Puede obtener el nombre, dirección y número de teléfono de ese juez comunicándose con la Oficina de Administración del Tribunal de Asuntos Tributarios o consultando la página web www.njcourts.gov, en la sección de Tribunal de Asuntos Tributarios.
- Al presentar un pedimento, debe enviar simultáneamente copias de todos los documentos a la otra parte. La Certificación de Notificación es su declaración de que ha entregado a la parte contraria una copia de todos los documentos y que ha presentado el original ante el Tribunal.
- Las fechas de resolución de pedimentos generalmente son cada dos viernes. Puede obtener las fechas exactas llamando a la oficina del juez asignado a su caso.
