VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Address juveniles charged with minor offenses or provoking a family crisis.

-Juvenile Conference Committee

Monitor case plans for abused and neglected children removed from their homes.

-Child Placement Review Board

Serve as a courtroom or courthouse aide.

-Family or Civil Division

Help domestic violence victims in navigating the court process.

-Family Division

Mediate neighborhood disputes to reach mutual agreements.

-Municipal Court Mediation

Supervise visits between non-custodial parent and child.

-Family Division

Act as “a child’s voice in court” for children in foster care.

-Court Appointed Special Advocates

Examine case file documents and review reports to help protect incapacitated adults.

-Guardianship Monitoring Program
