Order #5. Order Releasing Defendant Who Lacks Fitness to Proceed But Is Not A Danger Under Certain Conditions.

This order is to be used in cases where a defendant has been found incompetent but there is no finding that they represent a danger to themselves, others, or property. In accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 2C:4-6(b) the court may direct the defendant to continue with outpatient treatment in such circumstances. The order states that the case would be held in abeyance. In cases where Ann Klein Forensic Center staff performed the initial evaluation, any follow up competency evaluation would be done by a psychologist from the Ann Klein Forensic Center.
