## **Descriptive Comments**

Sanity Order 7. Order Mandating a Specified Community Placement Pursuant to Conditions of a Defendant Who Has Been Determined Unfit to Proceed to Trial but Not Dangerous to Self, Others or Property As a Result of Mental Illness

The text of the following proposed order has been drafted for use when the court has determined that the defendant is unfit to proceed to trial but that the defendant is not so dangerous to self, others or property as a result of mental illness as to require institutionalization. Under such circumstances, the court may order the defendant placed in a supervised community setting, if available, and establish conditions which the defendant must meet such as participation in therapy, enrollment in a partial care program, continuation of prescribed medication, etc.
