The text of the following two proposed orders have been drafted for use when the court has determined that a defendant is fit to proceed to trial or has regained his fitness to proceed to trial but the defendant is not dangerous to self, others or property as a result of mental illness. As a result, the court cannot commit the defendant and must therefore make other arrangements for any needed confinement or supervision.
