Within ten (10) days, pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R 1:28-2 and submit an Affidavit of Compliance to the Ethics Financial Committee and the New Jersey Lawyers Fund for client protection, and these payments shall be made any year in which Gerald F. - 8.
