January 31, 2018 Defendants shall identify its liability experts and serve liability expert reports, if any, by this

date or waive any opportunity to rely on liability expert testimony.

ECONOMIST EXPERT REPORTS

November 30, 2017 Plaintiff shall identify its expert economists and serve expert economist report(s), if any, by

this date or waive any opportunity to rely on economic expert testimony.

January 31, 2018 Defendants shall identify its expert economists and serve expert economist report(s), if any,
