THIS MATTER, having come before the Court, upon the submission by Plaintiffs of the final version of the Order entered in the Benicar (Olmesartan) Products Liability Litigation MDL Master Docket No. 15-2606, and in furtherance of State and Federal Court coordination;

IT IS on this //hday of October, 2016 ORDERED as follows:

Plaintiffs shall identify one detail representative they request to depose with respect to each bellwether plaintiff by September 30, 2016. Defendants are not required to produce the detail representatives' custodial files. However, after plaintiffs identify the detail representatives they request to depose, defendants shall produce all documents prepared by, sent to, or received by the detail representatives regarding the bellwether plaintiff's treating and prescribing physicians, including but not limited to, and to the extent not already done, all call notes, diary notes, and calendar entries. Defendants also shall produce detail representative deponent's final annual performance evaluations. The documents shall be produced at least two (2) weeks before each deponent's deposition is first noticed. This Order is entered without prejudice to plaintiffs' right to request the deposition of more than one detail representative for a bellwether plaintiff upon good cause shown; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order shall not supersede or expand the requirements of Case Management Order No. 4 and the requirements in the Defendant Fact Sheet; and it is further

ORDERED that a true and correct copy of this order shall be served on all parties within (7) days of the date hereof.
