This matter comes before the Court by way of Plaintiff's Motion to Reinstate the Complaint to the active trial calendar. The Court notes that no opposition was filed. By way of April 17, 2025 Order, this Court ordered that all cases listed in Exhibit A of same order were dismissed without prejudice. The order further stated that if Plaintiffs failed to move to reinstate in accordance with the February 10, 2025 Case Management Order, and pursuant to R. 4:34-1 to substitute an authorized Personal Representative for the Estate of a deceased Plaintiff identified on Exhibit A, within 60 days of the April 17, 2025, Order, counsel for Defendants may file a motion to dismiss those cases with prejudice. More than 90-days from this Court's April 17, 2025 Order, Defendants have not moved to dismiss this case with prejudice.
