**ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** having been opened to the Court on application of Dughi, Hewit & Domalewski, P.C., attorneys for Defendants Genentech, Inc., Hoffmann-La Roche Inc., GlaxoSmithKline LLC, and Roche Laboratories Inc., for an Order granting admission *pro hac vice*

of Mary R. Pawelek, Esq., and the Court having considered the certifications of counsel filed in support of the application in compliance with R. 1:21-2, and good cause having been shown,

**IT IS** on this 4th day of August, 2023;

**ORDERED** that Mary R. Pawelek, Esq., is hereby GRANTED admission *pro hac vice* to practice before this Court in this matter. In accordance with New Jersey Court Rule 1:21-2(b), Mary R. Pawelek, Esq., shall:

(1) Abide by the New Jersey Rules of Court, including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:1-20-1 and R. 1:28-2;

(2) consent to appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against Counsel or Counsel's law firm that may arise out of Counsel's participation in this matter;

(3) notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting Counsel's standing at the bar of any other court;

(4) have all pleadings, briefs, and other papers filed with the court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this State, who shall be held responsible for them and for the conduct of the case and of the admitted Counsel herein; and

(5) not be designated as trial counsel and must be accompanied by a member of the New Jersey bar for all proceedings, unless specifically waived by the Court.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Mary R. Pawelek shall make payment of any fees due to the State of New Jersey within 30 days of the entry of the *pro hac vice* Order allowing for admission and as provided in the New Jersey Rules of Court, R. 1:20-1(b), R. 1:28-2, and R. 1:28B-1(e). **NOTE:** Ms. Pawelek as has already made payment to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for
