CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 36

THIS MATTER having come before the Court during the January 10, 2019 Case Management Conference, and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this 24 day of January, 2019, ORDERED, as follows:

The schedule for filing dispositive motions pursuant to <u>In Re Accutane Litig.</u>, 235
N.J. 229 (2018) is as follows:

a. Defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment to be filed by February 28, 2019;

b. Plaintiffs' oppositions to Defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment, if any, shall be

due by March 22, 2019;

c. Defendants' replies shall be due by April 5, 2019; and

d. The motions will be returnable at the April 24, 2019 case management conference.

2. By <u>January 24, 2019</u>, Plaintiff's counsel in the <u>Warnet matter (MID-L-9956-14)</u> shall provide defense counsel with a reasonable list of documents identified by Bates number from Defendants' prior document productions that he would like to be re-produced at his expense. Within two weeks of receiving Plaintiff's list, Defendants will re-produce copies of the documents in electronic format. Defendants will provide Plaintiff's counsel with an invoice for any costs associated with re-producing of these documents.

3. By <u>February 11, 2019</u>, Plaintiff in the <u>Dermody</u> matter (MID-L-9739-14) shall provide a signed stipulation of dismissal with prejudice. If Plaintiff does not provide the signed

stipulation of dismissal by February 11, 2019, Defendants may file a motion to dismiss pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 4:37-2.

4. By <u>February 11, 2019</u>, Napoli Shkolnik shall provide Defendants with all lien documentation pursuant to Paragraph 5 of the March 28, 2016 Master Settlement Agreement.

5. The next case management conference will be held on  $M_{0} \rightarrow 19$  at 10:00
