PROPOSED | CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

THIS MATTER having come before the Court after counsel met and conferred, and for good cause shown:

IT IS on this 6^{49} day of 0ctobeR, 2017, **ORDERED** as follows:

With respect to the *Joanne Lewis, et al. v. C. R. Bard, Inc., et al.* matter (Docket No.: L-19011-14), the Court sets forth the following deadlines, which shall supersede any deadlines in all prior scheduling orders:

- 1. Defendants will serve their urogynecology expert reports by October 20, 2017;
- 2. Plaintiffs will serve their expert witness reports by November 15, 2017;
- 3. Defendants will serve their additional expert witness reports by December 15, 2017;
- 4. Plaintiffs' expert witnesses will be deposed by January 29, 2018 (commencing after defense expert reports have been served);
- 5. Defendants' expert witnesses will be deposed by February 28, 2018;
- 6. The Parties will be entitled to conduct remaining fact discovery until February 15, 2018, with the exception that the Parties will be entitled to take the following depositions until sixty (60) days prior to the scheduled beginning of trial:
 - a. Plaintiff Joanne Lewis' supplemental deposition, limited to matters occurring since her prior deposition and further limited to three (3) hours;
 - b. Family and friend witnesses that Plaintiffs intend to call at trial; and

c. Treating physicians limited to Plaintiff's relevant, new conditions and treatment related to such conditions.
