All prior orders remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Order.

THIS MATTER having been reassigned to the Bergen County Vicinage, from Atlantic County, pursuant to the Supreme Court's Order of October 31, 2014; the Court having conducted a Case Management Conference on March 31, 2026; counsel appearing; for good cause shown and for the reasons set forth on the record;

IT IS on this 14TH day of April, 2026, **ORDERED** as follows:

I. TRIAL SETTING.

A. Trial Settings.

- a. The parties will report to the Court at the next CMC about the status of activated cases from which a next trial setting might be set.

II. CASE MANAGEMENT.

- A. Status of Remaining Active Cases Subject to Pre-CMO 126 Discovery Activation Orders.** Not including the cases activated under CMO 126 entered on December 11, 2025, and discussed below, there remain a total of 59 active cases.¹ *Exhibit A identifies the active cases that remain in ongoing discovery.* Of the 59 cases, there are 55 that are under the ongoing requirement to proceed with records collection, production of

authorizations, and all other outstanding discovery obligations.² 23 cases are subject to multiple different scheduling orders as follows.

1. **Cases Subject to Alternative or Individual Scheduling Orders (21 cases)**. Attached at Exhibit B is a list of cases subject to Alternative &/or Individual Case Scheduling Orders. Copies of those orders will not be appended to this CMO 130.
 2. **CMO 116 Cases Subject to CMO 117 Scheduling Order Entered April 1, 2025**. Of the 107 activated cases, 1 currently remains active and compliant (Eby, Shirley (deceased) BER-L-16222-14), but not subject to a scheduling order.
 3. **Cases Subject to CMO 119 Scheduling Order Entered April 22, 2025**. No cases remain subject to CMO 119 Scheduling Order.
 4. **Case Subject to CMO 123 Scheduling Order Entered September 24, 2025 (1 case)**. 1 case currently remains subject to CMO 123 (Haskins, Wendy BER-L-003173-24).
- B. CMO 126 Discovery Activation Order**. CMO 126, entered on December 11, 2025, activated an additional 200 MSA Exhibit B cases and contained the milestone deadline of January 9, 2026, for updating of the PFS and updated authorizations. Of the 200 cases activated by CMO 126, 101 remain active and 0 are currently compliant. Defendants served 101 Notices of Imminent Motion to dismiss for failure to comply. Motions are anticipated in these cases if agreements are not reached with plaintiffs' counsel to resolve in an alternative manner. Defendants are currently providing compliance deadline extensions on a case by case basis.

PARTIES SHALL NOTE THAT COMPLIANCE WITH PFS-RELATED DEADLINES FOR ALL ACTIVE CASES, REQUIRES THE PROVISION, *INTER ALIA*, OF THE MOST CURRENT UPDATED RECORDS RELEASE AUTHORIZATIONS, which were appended to the "Updated and Amended Notice and Order Regarding Service of Plaintiff's Fact Sheets, Required Records Authorizations and Applications for Extensions of Service Dates, entered on September 16, 2025. - C. **Active Cases Not Subject to any Scheduling Order**. Any Plaintiff with a compliant case that is not subject to a current scheduling order, shall evaluate records collection status and meet and confer with Defense Counsel to assess whether sufficient medical records have been collected to begin scheduling plaintiffs' depositions. As those cases progress, Plaintiff and Defense Counsel shall likewise meet and confer as to scheduling plaintiffs' depositions.

III. ADDITIONAL CASES TO BE ACTIVATED

- A. **Newly Filed Cases**. All cases filed since the entry of CMO 105 are considered activated. Such cases are not to await any specific activation order. The below newly filed cases have specifically been identified since the last case management conference and are listed below by way of example. Records collection shall proceed immediately upon timely service, as required by the current protocols, of fully-compliant plaintiffs' fact sheets and all required current authorizations. Plaintiffs' depositions shall be scheduled as soon as practicable upon collection of the requisite records. The following are identified among those in this category.

1. Ortiz, Nancy v. Ethicon, Inc., et al., BER-L-003042-26
2. Carpenter, Arthella v. Ethicon, Inc., et al., BER-L-003167-26

All newly filed cases are considered active and must comply with the MCL protocols regarding service of PFS. The proper authorization forms currently can be found appended to the Updated PFS protocol entered by the Court on September 16, 2025.

- B. **Activation of MSA Exhibit B Cases**. There remain active on the docket over 500 cases involving plaintiffs who allege they have a currently marketed Ethicon SUI product implanted, but have not had a revision surgery, which cases are identified on Exhibits B to their plaintiffs' firms' Master Settlement Agreements ("MSA"). Cases in this category were activated under CMOs 116/117, 121 and 123. To the extent the cases are active, their discovery status is covered by Paragraph III(A), above. When appropriate, Defendants will submit another proposed order to the Court to activate additional cases in this category.

1. **CMO 116 and CMO 117**. The only active CMO 116 case remaining is Eby, Shirley BER-L-16222-14. Case management Order 117 entered on April 1, 2025, contained the milestone deadlines for, among other things, update of PFS and updated authorizations.
2. **CMO 121**. CMO 121 was entered on May 30, 2025. CMO 121 activated an additional 37 cases. Currently 21 cases remain active.

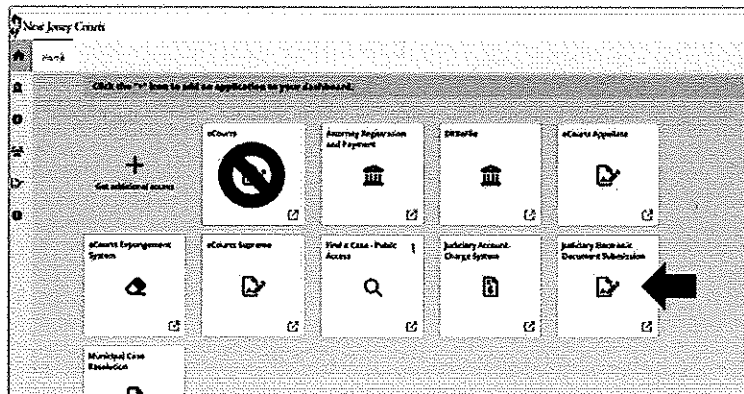
3. **CMO 123** CMO 123 (Amended) was entered on October 15, 2025. CMO 123 set forth an updated discovery completion schedule for 28 of the previously activated cases. Currently there is 1 case that remains subject to CMO 123 (Amended): Haskins, Wendy BER-L-003173-24.

IV. MOTIONS & COURT SUBMISSIONS.

1. **Deceased Plaintiff cases.** Defendants filed an application to the Court on February 17, 2026 regarding 21 Cases in which the Plaintiff died after the filing of the Complaint but no substitution for a proper party in Interest has been filed. Of the 21 cases, 4 have since been dismissed and one has a pending DWOP order. *Exhibit C is a list of the 21 cases and identifies the 5 that have been or will be dismissed and indicates those subject to CMO 126 activation.*
2. **Pending Motions.** The Court was provided with the list of motions pending and submitted orders for entry as per the Defendants records with the Agenda for the 3/31/26 CMC and Defense Liaison Counsel continues to work with the Clerk's office to track the status of same.

V. FILINGS ON ECOURTS

All Counsel and parties to this MCL are reminded that this is a JEDS (Judiciary Electronic Document Submission) system litigation. Counsel are **not** to use eCourts to file pleadings and other documents. This MCL requires paper filing or filing through the JEDS submission system.



Any fees charged through an improper submission on eCourts will not be refunded. Please see CMO 96 regarding service and filing notifications. **Also, JEDS submission does not equate with service. Anything submitted via JEDS (or in paper format) must be served on all counsel of record separately in accordance with the Rules of Court and/or protocols in this MCL (unless counsel have consented to receive service via email only).**
