WHEREAS an Order dated August 4, 2025, relieving counsel of record provided that if plaintiff did not within 40 days of the date of the Order notify the Court in writing that she either has new counsel or intends to prosecute the case *pro se*, the matter would be deemed dismissed without prejudice and counsel for Defendants may submit an order to that effect without further notice to the plaintiff, and

WHEREAS the matter was dismissed without prejudice pursuant to the August 4, 2025, Order as of September 15, 2025 (by Order dated September 30, 2025, and

WHEREAS an Order dated August 4, 2025, relieving counsel of record provided that if plaintiff did not within 60 days of the date of dismissal without prejudice reinstate the Complaint, the matter would be deemed dismissed with prejudice and counsel for Defendants may submit an order to that effect without further notice to the plaintiff, and

WHEREAS the Complaint has not been reinstated, and


WHEREAS Defendants now request the entry of an order documenting the dismissal with
