This litigation was previously assigned to this Court for centralized management without mass tort designation. Only four (4) cases remain on the Court's docket. The Court previously obtained from Chief Justice Stuart Rabner permission to refer the remaining four cases to mediation.

At the June 4, 2019 Case Management Conference, the Court advised the parties of its intent to refer the cases to mediation and the parties sought time to determine if they could agree on a mediator. The Court granted the parties' request.

b. Marie Goodson v. Wyeth, LLC, et al., Docket No. MID-L-010337-14

shall participate in mediation in good faith before the Honorable John E. Keefe, Sr. (Ret.) on September 24, 2019;
