ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, all plaintiffs represented by the Sheller Law Firm shall verify that the information set forth in their previously submitted Long Form Plaintiff Fact Sheets ("LFPFS") is true and accurate.
- 2. Each plaintiff represented by the Sheller Law Firm shall execute an affidavit or certification attesting to the accuracy of the information set forth in their previously submitted LFPFS. If any plaintiff is deceased or legally incapacitated, then an appropriate representative for the deceased plaintiff or legally incapacitated plaintiff must sign the affidavit or certification.
- 3. If any of the information contained in previously submitted LFPFS is inaccurate for any reason, plaintiffs represented by the Sheller Law Firm shall provide amended LFPFS with the supplemental or additional information within thirty (30) days of the date of this order.
- 4. If any plaintiffs represented by the Sheller Law Firm fail to comply with the requirements of Paragraphs 1 through 3 of this order, then counsel for defendant

Janssen may file motions to dismiss the complaints of the non-compliant plaintiffs. The motion to dismiss shall be without prejudice.

5. A copy of this order shall be posted on line by the court within seven (7) days of the date of this order.
