(collectively "AstraZeneca") to dismiss the Complaint of plaintiff Amy Huffman with prejudice for failure to provide outstanding authorizations and/or missing information pursuant to Case Management Orders 4 ("CMO 4") and 19 ("CMO 19") and the August 14, 2009 Order of the Court, such

ORDERED that upon being served with the within order of dismissal with prejudice, plaintiff's counsel shall forthwith serve a copy of this order on the plaintiff by regular and certified mail, return receipt requested.
