**ORDER GRANTING
ADMISSION *PRO HAC VICE*

THIS MATTER having been brought before the Court by Steven J. Sico, Esq. on a Motion for an Order granting admission *pro hac vice* to ALISON RAE ASHMORE, Esq., an attorney of the firm of Rogge Dunn Group PC and a member of the Texas State Bar, to participate with other counsel for Plaintiff in pre-trial proceedings, depositions, discovery proceedings, and trial in this matter and the Court having read the moving papers and opposition thereto, if any; and having considered the arguments of counsel; and for good cause shown;

IT IS on this 15TH day of DECEMBER, 2025

ORDERED that Alison Rae Ashmore, Esq. be and hereby is admitted *pro hac vice* and is authorized to appear and participate with other counsel for Plaintiff in all phases of discovery and trial, which concerns a complex area of law about which Alison Rae Ashmore, Esq. is specialized; subject to the following conditions:

1) Alison Rae Ashmore, Esq. shall abide by the New Jersey Court Rules, including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2.

2) Alison Rae Ashmore Esq. shall, and hereby does, consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as his agent upon whom service of process may be made for actions against him that may arise out of his participation in the matter.

3) Alison Rae Ashmore, Esq. shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.

4) Alison Rae Ashmore, Esq. shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by Steven J. Sico, Esq., who is admitted to practice in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation, and the attorney admitted herein.

5) Alison Rae Ashmore, Esq. cannot be designated as trial counsel.

6) Alison Rae Ashmore, Esq. shall within ten (10) days of this Order, pay the fees required by New Jersey Rules of Court, R. 1:20-1(b), R. 1:28B-1(e) and R. 1:28-2, and shall submit an affidavit of compliance.

7) No discovery, motion, trial, or any other proceeding delay shall occur or be requested by reason of the inability of Alison Rae Ashmore, Esq. to be in attendance.

8) Automatic termination of *pro hac vice* admission shall occur for failure to make the required payment of the annual fee to the Lawyer's Assistance Fund and the NJ Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection. Proof of such payment, after filing proof of payment, shall be made no later than February 1st of each year.

9) Non-compliance with any of the terms of this order shall constitute grounds for removal.

10) A copy of this order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
