8) Automatic termination of pro hac vice admission shall occur for failure to make the

required payment of the annual fee to the Lawyer's Assistance Fund and the NJ Lawyer's Fund for

Client Protection. Proof of such payment, after filing proof of payment, shall be made no later

than February 1st of each year.

9) Non-compliance with any of the terms of this order shall constitute grounds for

removal.

10) A copy of this order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days of the date

hereof.
