1. Plaintiff Fact Sheets

Further production of Plaintiff Fact Sheets and proof of product usage will proceed as forth in CMO #6. If a Plaintiff fails to cure a deficiency within the Cure Period set forth in section 1. of CMO #6, Defendants may seek permission from the Court to file a Motion to Compel (if Plaintiff Fact Sheet information is deficient) or a Motion to Dismiss (if Plaintiff has failed to comply with a Motion to Compel Order). Defendants shall wait at least two days after permission is sought before the Motion to Compel or Motion to Dismiss is filed.

2. Errata Sheets: Cross Noticed Depositions

Errata sheets will be permitted for cross-noticed depositions in this litigation without the need to file a motion to correct the transcript. Formal consent orders are not required and counsel have consented to exchange of errata sheets on cross noticed depositions for the duration of the litigation.

3. Amendments of Pleadings: Correction of Technical Errors or Misspellings

Plaintiffs' counsel will provide defense counsel with a list of cases for which they have identified pleadings with technical errors and/or misspellings, identify the specific error and the proposed amendment. Counsel shall meet and confer to determine if defense counsel will consent to an amendment through submission of a consent order.

4. Next Case Management Conference

The next Case Management Conference is scheduled for February 21, 2024, at 3:00 P.M. via zoom.
