IT IS, ON THIS 14th Day of November 2025 **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

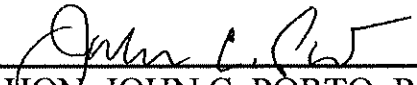
- That the Fourth Amended Case Management Order 9 deadlines are extended thirty (30) days as follows:
