**THIS MATTER** having been brought by Barnes & Thornburg LLP, attorneys for Defendants Johnson & Johnson, Johnson & Johnson Holdco (NA) Inc., Janssen Pharmaceuticals, Inc., Kenvue Inc., LLT Management LLC f/k/a LTL Management LLC, and Johnson & Johnson Services, Inc. (collectively, the “Johnson & Johnson Defendants”) respectfully move for the admission *pro hac vice* of Ashley R. Phillips, of the law firm Kirkland & Ellis LLP located at 601 Lexington Avenue, New York, NY 10022, an attorney in good standing in the State bar of New York and is admitted in the following jurisdictions: the Eastern District of Virginia, the Western District of Virginia, the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit, the Commonwealth

of Virginia and the state of New York. Ashley Phillips is not under suspension or disbarment by any court. There are no disciplinary proceedings pending against them in any jurisdiction. The Johnson & Johnson Defendants have requested that they appear together with Ms. Brennan and other attorneys from Barnes & Thornburg LLP to represent them in this matter. The Johnson & Johnson Defendants respectfully move for the admission *pro hac vice* of Ashley Phillips pursuant to an Order submitted under the 5-day Rule, and the Court having received no objections to the within Order and for good cause having been shown:

IT IS on this 29 DAY OF September, 2025:

**ORDERED** that the application for the *pro hac vice* admission of Ashley Phillips on behalf of the Johnson & Johnson Defendants is **GRANTED**, subject to the following conditions:


1. Ashley R. Phillips, Esq. shall abide by all rules and laws of the State of New Jersey, including disciplinary rules, Rules 1:20-1 and 1:28-2.
2. Ashley R. Phillips, Esq. shall and hereby does consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the New Jersey Supreme Court as agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against them or their law firm that may arise out of their participation in this matter.
3. Ashley R. Phillips, Esq. shall contact the Court immediately about any matter that may affect their standing in any jurisdiction in which they are admitted.
4. Ashley R. Phillips, Esq. shall have all pleadings, briefs, and other papers filed with the court signed by an attorney of records authorized to practice in New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein.
5. Ashley R. Phillips, Esq. cannot be designated as trial counsel pursuant to Rule 4:25-

6. Ashley R. Phillips, Esq. shall make an annual payment to the Ethics Financial Committee and to the New Jersey Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection and shall, within ten (10) days, pay the fee required by Rules 1:20-1(b), 1:28-2, and 1:28B-1(e) and submit an affidavit of compliance.

7. The *pro hac vice* admission of Ashley R. Phillips, Esq. will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payments required by Rules 1:20-1(b), 1:28-2, and 1:28B-1(e).

8. Noncompliance with any of these requirements shall constitute grounds for removal.

9. A true copy of this Order shall be served upon all parties within seven (7) days.
