**ORDER OF DISMISSAL

THIS MATTER having been brought before the Court upon Motion by Harris Beach PLLC, counsel for Defendant Novartis Pharmaceuticals Corporation, to dismiss for failure to timely serve the required authorizations with a Plaintiff Fact Sheet in compliance with Case Management Order No. 3, and having considered the motion and any opposition thereto, and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this 28th day of April, 2023,

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Court GRANTS Defendant's Motion to Dismiss without prejudice for failure to timely serve the required authorization with Plaintiff Fact Sheet.

2. Plaintiffs' Complaints and all claims against All Defendants in the actions listed on Schedule A are hereby dismissed without prejudice.

3. Regarding paragraph 2 above, pursuant to Section E of Case Management Order, Plaintiffs shall have thirty (30) days from the date of this Order to serve upon Defendant the required authorizations in pursuant to Case Management Order No. 3 and move before this Court for reinstatement of the Complaints and payment of the appropriate fee.

4. Any refiling of this action must occur in New Jersey Superior Court *Bergen County*.

5. In the event of Plaintiffs' failure to comply with paragraph 3 above, this dismissal without prejudice will be converted to dismissals with prejudice upon Defendant's motion.

6. Service of this Order shall be deemed effectuated upon all parties upon its upload to e-Courts.
