**ORDER GRANTING
SHANNON N. PROCTOR, ESQ.'S
ADMISSION *PRO HAC VICE***

This matter having been brought to the Court's attention by counsel for Defendant NOVARTIS PHARMACEUTICALS CORPORATION ("NPC") for an order permitting Shannon N. Proctor, an attorney of Hollingsworth, LLP admitted to the practice of law in the states of Georgia, Florida, and the District of Columbia, to participate with other counsel for NPC in all phases of this matter, and it appearing that Shannon Proctor is in good standing with the relevant authorities or Bar of the states Georgia, Florida, and the District of Columbia, and, and it appearing that Hollingsworth, LLP has a long standing attorney-client relationship involving several matters for NPC, and that NPC has requested that Ms. Proctor represent them in this matter:

It is on this 13th day of February, 2023,

ORDERED that Shannon N. Proctor be and hereby is admitted *pro hac vice* for cases listed in **Schedule A** and is authorized to appear and participate with other counsel for NPC in all phases of this matter, subject to the following conditions:

1. Said attorney shall abide by the New Jersey Rules of Court, including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2.

2. Said attorney shall and hereby does consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as her agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against her that may arise out of her individual participation in this matter.

3. Said attorney shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting her standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.

4. Said attorney shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein.

5. Said attorney cannot be designated as trial counsel.

6. No proceedings in this matter will be adjourned if said attorney is unavailable.

7. Said attorney must, within ten days of entry of this Order, pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2, and submit affidavits of compliance.

8. *Pro hac vice* admission will automatically terminate for failure to make the required annual payments to the Ethics Financial Committee and the New Jersey Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection. Proof of such payment, after filing proof of the initial payment shall be made no later than February of each year.

9. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this Order shall constitute grounds for removal.

10. Service of this Order shall be deemed effectuated upon all parties upon its upload to e-Courts.
