5. The deadline to submit certificates of compliance for *pro hac vice* admissions that

were granted on March 27, 2020 and June 2, 2020 is hereby extended until June 30, 2020.

**a.m.** before the Undersigned. Counsel may appear telephonically if desired. The Parties

shall submit a joint agenda to the Court listing the issues for the case management

conference, via e-mail, by July 14, 2020. Liaison Counsel for the Plaintiffs shall circulate

Counsel shall send a proposed agenda to Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel on or before July 7,
