- 3. M. Palmer Lambert, Esq. shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing before this Court;
- 4. M. Palmer Lambert, Esq. shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court in this action signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this State, specifically the New York, New York office of Robins Kaplan LLP, who shall be responsible for them and for the conduct of the cause and of the admitted attorney herein;
- 5. M. Palmer Lambert, Esq. must, within 10 days, pay the fees required by Rule 1:20-1(b) and Rule 1:28-2 and submit affidavits of compliance;
- 6. Automatic termination of *pro hac vice* admission will occur for failure to make the required annual payments to the Ethics Financial Committee and the New Jersey Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection. Proof of such payment, after filing proof of the initial payment, shall be made no later than February 1st, of each year;
- Non-compliance with any of these requirements shall constitute grounds for removal; and,
- 8. That a copy of this Order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days.
