IT IS this 26th day of July 2021, hereby:

ORDERED that the motion is **GRANTED**, and Virginia E. Anello, Esq. shall be and hereby is admitted *pro hac vice* for Plaintiffs Avrum David Berkowitz and Anne Berkowitz subject to the following conditions:

responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein; and

5. Virginia E. Anello, Esq. cannot be designated as trial counsel and must be

accompanied by a member of the New Jersey bar for all proceedings, unless specifically waived

by the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Virginia E. Anello, Esq. must make an annual payment

to the Ethics Financial Committee and to the New Jersey Lawyers Fund for Client Protection and

shall, within thirty (30) days, pay the fees required by Rules 1:20-1(b), 1:28-2 and 1:28B-1(e) and

submit an affidavit of compliance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the *pro hac vice* admission of Virginia E. Anello, Esq.

will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payment required by

Rules 1:20-1(b), 1:282 and 1:28B-1(e).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that service of this Order shall be deemed effectuated upon all

parties upon its upload to e-Courts. Pursuant to Rule 1:5-1(a), movant shall serve a copy of this

Order on all parties not served electronically within seven (7) days of the date of this Order.
